RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved June 10, 1968

RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED:

That the following-named highway shown as a cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works-Engineering Office, Street Line Section Map No. 063206, Dated April 1, 1968",

viz: Smithfield Avenue and Selkirk Street, beginning at a point on the westerly line of Selkirk Street, said point being one hundred twelve and 04/100 (112.04) feet south of the intersection of the westerly line of Selkirk Street and the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence generally westerly in the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of twenty (20) feet and a central angle of $115^{\circ}-31'-20''$, forty and 32/100 (40.32) feet to a point on the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence northerly along the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue, seventeen and 63/100 (17.63) feet to a point of curve; thence generally easterly in the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of twelve (12) feet and a central angle of $163^{\circ}-04'-00''$, thirty-four and 15/100 (34.15) feet to the tangent point of said curve at the westerly line of Selkirk Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Selkirk Street, thirty-one and 42/100 (31.42) feet to the point and place of beginning as it appears on accompanying Plan No. 063206; having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is abandoned as a public highway, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway," and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice

Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Selkirk Street, said point being one hundred twelve and 04/100 (112.04) feet south of the intersection of the westerly line of Selkirk Street and the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence generally westerly in the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of twenty (20) feet and a central angle of $115^{\circ}-31'-20''$, forty and 32/100 (40.32) feet to a point on the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence northerly along the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue, seventeen and 63/100 (17.63) feet to a point of curve; thence generally easterly in the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of twelve (12) feet and a central angle of $163^{\circ}-04'00''$, thirty-four and 15/100 (34.15) feet to the tangent point of said curve at the westerly line of Selkirk Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Selkirk Street, thirty-one and 42/100 (31.42) feet to the point and place of beginning as it appears on accompanying Plan No. 063206.

DESCRIPTION OF A PORTION OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY
TO BE ABANDONED AT SMITHFIELD AVENUE AND
SELKIRK STREET

THAT certain tract or parcel of land situated at Smithfield Avenue and Selkirk Street in the City of Providence, R. I., shown as shaded area and designated by the letters A-B-C-D-A on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, R. I., P. W. Dept.-Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063206, Date April 1, 1968", bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point marked "A" on the accompanying plan, on the westerly line of Selkirk Street, said point being one hundred twelve and 04/100 (112.04) feet south of the intersection of the westerly line of Selkirk Street and the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence generally westerly in the arc of a curve to the left, having a radius of twenty (20) feet and a central angle of $115^{\circ}-31'-15"$, forty and 32/100 (40.32) feet to a point marked "B" on the accompanying plan, on the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue; thence northerly along the easterly line of Smithfield Avenue, seventeen and 63/100 (17.63) feet to a point of curve marked "C" on the accompanying plan; thence generally easterly in the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of twelve (12) feet and a central angle of $163^{\circ}-04'-00"$, thirty-four and 15/100 (34.15) feet to the tangent point of said curve at the westerly line of Selkirk Street at point marked "D" on the accompanying plan; thence southerly along the westerly line of Selkirk Street, thirty-one and 42/100 (31.42) feet to the point marked "A" on the accompanying plan and the point and place of beginning.

Said parcel contains 630 square feet.
