RESOLVED

THAT His Honor the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to execute a lease to George Mann & Company, Inc. of approximately 60,000 square feet of land at Fields Point adjacent to land presently leased to G. E. Wilson Company, said lease to be for a period of twenty (20) years, the rent to be 8¢ a square foot for the first five years and negotiated each five-year period thereafter, and to contain such terms and conditions as may be approved by His Honor the Mayor and the City Solicitor.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is authorized to renew the lease of G. E. Wilson Company of land at Fields Point for a period of twenty (20) years, with the rental for the first five (5) years at the rate of 8¢ a square foot, and to be negotiated each five-year period thereafter, with a provision that G.E. Wilson Company be given an option for five (5) years to lease an additional 38,015 square feet, at said 8¢ per square foot, and to pay for said option during said period of five (5) years an escalated price per square foot of .01, .01½, .02, .03, .05, respectively.







Proposed Lease Renewal indicated by shaded area lettered A-B-C-D-E-F-A.




SUBJECT: Proposed Abandonment of Portion of Rutherglen Avenue.

The southerly side of Rutherglen Avenue as originally platted on the Annie M. Wilcox plat terminated at a point 251.69 feet (more or less) west of Parkman Street.

In 1911 the City Council ordered the realignment and extension of Rutherglen Avenue thereby providing thru access to Pontiac Avenue.

A portion of the original highway from a point 164.72 feet west of Parkman Street to its westerly termination was no longer required for highway purposes but was never legally abandoned.

It is recommended that this portion of the original highway be abandoned at this time and annexed to the abutting properties.

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, March 17, 1964.

This referral is a request to abandon as a public highway that portion of Rutherglen Avenue from a point 164.72 feet more or less westerly from Parkman Street to its former termination as shown on the Annie W. Wilcox Plat on Plat Card 621 recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the triangular portion of the street in question is fronting on Rutherglen Avenue and part of a block bounded by Rutherglen Avenue, Parkman Street, Sinclair Avenue and Pontiac Avenue. The area involved contains approximately 2,100 square feet of land.

The relocation of a segment of Rutherglan Avenue is a platted and recorded segment of the avenue and the excess triangular portion of City-owned property will no longer serve a useful street purpose. Since the proposed abandonment will not affect the vehicular circulation system,


