

Dear Honorable Members:

I hereby disapprove and veto the Ordinance in amendment of Section 21-16 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence granting an extension of the appeal deadlines for the automobile excise tax.

I have taken this action because extension of the deadline for filing appeals would require an amendment to the City Charter which can only be accomplished by a Legislative enactment. Furthermore, as I previously indicated in my veto message to you of September 11, 1981, whereby I disapproved and vetoed the Ordinance in amendment of Chapter 21 of the Code of Ordinances adding Section 21-16, an excise tax is not the type of tax enumerated in Section 6.12 of the City Charter which provides for tax appeals.

No. **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 21-16 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE BY GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF THE APPEAL DEADLINE FOR AUTOMOBILES.

Approved

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 21-16 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is hereby amended by adding the following:

"Said board shall grant an extension of the period for filing appeals on said excise tax, in fiscal year 1981-1982, until thirty (30) days following passage and/or approval of this Ordinance. "

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its Passage.
