AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 544, ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, ARTICLE V, SEC. 54 C-4, A-3 ENTITLED "AUTOMOBILE SERVICE STATION", ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR INCREASING THE GALLONAGE IN PRESENT AND FUTURE AUTOMOBILE SERVICE STATIONS.

Approved December 18, 1970

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Lot Requirements-

On application to the Director of the Department of Building Inspection for any increase in the total storage capacity of petroleum products to a maximum of 20,000 gallons for automobile service stations it shall be permitted only where the following lot requirements are complied with;

- (a) Minimum lot size-twelve thousand (12,000) square feet.
- (b) Minimum depth of lot-one hundred (100) feet.
- (c) Minimum lot width-one hundred twenty (120) feet.
- (d) Minimum setback line from all street lines-forty (40) feet.
- (e) Minimum distance from all property lines other than street lines-twenty (20) feet.
- (f) Minimum distance between any access driveway and any residential district-twenty-five (25) feet.
- (g) Minimum distance between pump islands, compressed air connections, and similar equipment and facilities and any street lines-twenty (20) feet.
- (h) Maximum width of curbcuts for access driveways-twenty-five (25) feet.

Section 2. Spacing of access driveways Minimum requirements;

- (1) Minimum distance from adjoining property lines-ten (10) feet.
- (2) Minimum distance from intersecting street lines-twenty (20) feet.
- (3) Minimum distance between access driveways-twenty (20) feet.

Section 3. Installation of Underground Storage Tanks-

Control over the installation of underground storage tanks shall be governed by the following distances from buildings and property lines.

The separation is related to tank size as follows:

The service station structure itself is exempted from separation distance if it has no basement or pits that extend lower than the top of the tank.

Section 4. Repairing and Washing Regulations-

It shall be required that any tire or tube repairing, battery charging, and storage of merchandise or supplies are conducted wholly within a building; provided further that any lubrication or washing not conducted within a building shall be permitted only if a solid wall compact evergreen screen or uniformly painted board fence not less than 4 feet high is erected and maintained between such uses and any adjoining R Zone and provided that the use area shall be developed as required in Section 24. (Ord. 1957, Chap. 1111.)

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, there are presently located in the City of Providence certain structures which are in a dilapidated and deteriorated condition; and

WHEREAS, the City of Providence is vitally interested in the preservation and rehabilitation of neighborhoods throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the demolition of certain of these structures will serve to promote the preservation and rehabilitation of these neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the owners of certain of these dilapidated and deteriorated structures are willing to convey title to these structures and to the land upon which they are located to the City of Providence without cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, by the acceptance of these deeds, the City of Providence will be enabled to demolish these structures with funds previously appropriated

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City of Providence hereby accepts deed in fee simple to the land and buildings hereinafter described from the owners thereof:

That parcel of land with all the buildings and other improvements thereon, situated on the northerly side of Mitchell Street, in the city of Providence, in the state of Rhode Island, bounded and described as follows:-

Beginning at a point in the northerly line of Mitchell Street two hundred and thirty (230) feet westerly from the point of intersection of said line of Mitchell Street with the westerly line of Hamilton Street, said point of beginning being at the southeasterly corner of said parcel and being also at the southeasterly corner of lot No. forty-one (41) on that Plat entitled "Melrose Street Estate in Elmwood Platted by John Howe 1872" and recorded in the office of the recorder of deeds in said Providence in Plat Book 11 at page 1 and (copy) on plat card 282, thence westerly bounding southerly on Mitchell Street forty (40) feet to the center line of a common driveway eight (8) feet in width hereinafter referred to; thence turning a right angle and running northerly along the center line of said common driveway and bounding westerly on land now or lately of Jasper Rustigian et al. sixty-eight (68) feet; thence turning an interior angle of $147^{\circ} 21'$ and running northeasterly bounding northwesterly on said last named land nine (9) feet; thence turning an exterior angle of $147^{\circ} 21'$ and running northerly bounding westerly on said last named land and running through the garage building located partly on said last named land and partly on the land herein described twenty-four and $42/100$ (24.42) feet to land now or lately of Charles A. Murray and wife; thence turning a right angle and running easterly bounding northerly on said Murray land thirty-five and $14/100$ (35.14) feet to land now or lately of John J. Galligan and wife; thence turning a right angle and running southerly bounding easterly on said Galligan land one hundred (100) feet to Mitchell Street at the point of beginning, at which point the last described line forms an interior angle of 90° with the first described line. Said parcel contains by estimation 3863 square feet of land, and comprises The major portion of lot No. 41 on said plat.

Also the right to use for all proper purposes of passing and repassing a strip of land four(4) feet in width extending northerly from the northerly line of Mitchell Street sixty-eight (68) feet, said strip of land bounding easterly on the westerly line of said lot No. 41 and comprising a

Reserving, however, from this conveyance the right to use for all proper purposes of passing and repassing a strip of land four (4) feet in width extending northerly from the northerly line of Mitchell Street sixty-eight (68) feet; said strip of land bounding westerly on the easterly line of said lot No. 42 and comprising a portion of said lot No. 41.

Said two strips of land each four (4) feet in width, together comprise a common driveway eight (8) feet in width extending northerly from the northerly line of Mitchell Street for a distance of sixty-eight (68) feet, the center line of which common driveway is the common property line between said lots Nos. 41 and 42.
