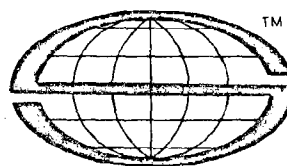


Dear Mr. Pearlman,

I am writing to ask that the tree in front of my house at 23 Adelphi Avenue be cut down. This tree, which is adjacent to my driveway, is half dead, and constitutes a hazard to passers by. Dead branches are falling off, and one may hit someone.

When I called Mr. Plant, the City Forester, I was informed that no funds are available for removal of hazardous trees. While I can understand the need for economy in City Government, I do feel that there ought to be money available to remedy dangerous situations. Perhaps in the long run it might be more economical to remove dead trees now, rather than have to be responsible for damages resulting when they fall on cars or people.
