WHEREAS, The State of Rhode Island, through its Department of Environmental Management is presently endeavoring to acquire open spaces for the recreational needs of its Citizens, and

WHEREAS, The upkeep and maintenance of the Park is now the financial responsibility of the dwindling numbers of Providence Taxpayers, and

WHEREAS, The luxury of providing this facility for the benefit of all Rhode Island Residents can no longer be afforded by the presently overburdened Taxpayers of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Park Commissioners initiate a meeting with the Honorable J. Joseph Garrahy for the purpose of discussing the acquisition of Roger Williams Park by the State and including it in its present Parks System.


