

## DOG OFFICER

**CLASS TITLE:** Dog Officer

**CLASS DEFINITION:** Responsible work of a supervisory nature in the enforcement of the dog license law and other laws affecting dogs and other animals and relating to the protection of the public health.

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF WORK:** Work involving the application of knowledge and experience in the handling and care of animals together with the personality and ability necessary to secure the cooperation of the public.

**ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:** Picks up and disposes of dead animals in a safe and sanitary manner, aids in enforcement of the dog license law, impounds and destroys unmuzzled or unimmunized dogs whenever the Superintendent of Health declares a danger of rabies, confines for observation any dog which has bitten a human being whenever so ordered by the Superintendent or Health.

**DESIRABLE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:** Considerable knowledge concerning the various breeds of dogs and other animals and their care and diseases. Knowledge of the various laws and ordinances pertaining to the keeping of dogs in the City of Providence together with knowledge of the administrative organization of the municipal government as it relates to these laws. Skill in approaching, handling and caring for dogs which may be sick or injured. Ability to deal with the general public in difficult situations requiring the application of patience, firmness and diplomacy.

**QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPOINTMENT:** Considerable experience in the keeping and care of dogs, a respect and liking for dogs and other animals, and a demonstrated ability in good public relations.







*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1350 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 16, 1960, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$40,869,634.16 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1961", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty (\$3,530) Dollars to GRANTS TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS, PROVIDENCE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty (\$3,530) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Three Thousand Five Hundred Thirty (\$3,530) Dollars.



**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

**Resolved,**

**That**

His Honor the Mayor be and he hereby is authorized to execute a lease to Cities Service Oil Company, a Delaware corporation, of approximately 212,080 square feet of land at Fields Point, Providence, Rhode Island. Said lease shall be for a 20-year period with the lessee to have options to renew for two successive periods of ten (10) years each. The rental for the 20-year period shall be eight cents per square foot or a base rental of SIXTEEN THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX and 40/100 (\$16,966.40) DOLLARS per year.

The lessee shall further pay ten cents per ton for each ton of liquid petroleum products and twenty cents per ton for packaged petroleum products delivered to or from the premises.

The lease shall further obligate the lessee to construct on the demised premises buildings and improvements, which with equipment and appurtenances, will cost not less than FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND (\$500,000) DOLLARS, and shall contain such further terms and conditions as may be approved by His Honor the Mayor and the City Solicitor.


