SECTION 1. The aforescribed Compensation Plan is hereby adopted for all City Officers and employees and shall be applied to each, except as hereinafter described.

In order to provide for periodic increases each position is categorized as one (1) of thirty-five (35) "Pay Grades", each of which contains five (5) steps.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Ordinance, any and all employees in the Office of the Mayor shall be excepted from any salary established herein so long as the total of the compensation for such employees does not exceed the annual budget appropriation for personal services in the office of the Mayor.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of this ordinance the compensation for department heads and legal assistants to the City Solicitor shall be no greater than those herein specified; however, any department head or legal assistant to the City Solicitor may be compensated at a rate lower than that established herein, and that lower compensation shall be allowed by this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this ordinance shall be retroactive to July 1, 1985.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
