
ORDER

This matter having come on for hearing before Superior Court December 17, 1998 and after hearing the arguments of counsel, it is hereby


ORDERED

1. The defendant shall produce all records that are the subject of this litigation (1986 to and including the present) to the plaintiff on or before January 8, 1999;
2. On or before January 5, 1999 the defendant, through its counsel, will contact plaintiff's counsel and advise when and where such records may be picked up by the plaintiff within the City of Providence;
3. The parties will submit on or before January 8, 1999 memoranda concerning the question of whether or not the Court may award attorneys' fees and whether or not the Court may waive copying costs and search and retrieval costs;
4. The plaintiff's counsel will submit, either by affidavit or testimony, evidence that the attorneys' fees it seeks are fair and reasonable.





