CHAPTER 1624

No. 356 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY TREASURER TO INVEST GENERAL FUND CASH IN CERTAIN SHORT TERM SECURITIES

Approved June 5, 1964

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The City Treasurer, with the advice and approval of the Finance Director, is hereby authorized to invest, from time to time, in either United States Government "Securities" or Bank "Certificates of Deposits" such sums of money in the General Fund of the City as may be deemed in excess of the amount required for the payments of current obligations of the City. Provided, however, that any such investment in securities or certificates from said fund, with a maturity in excess of six months, shall be made only with the approval of the City Council Finance Committee.

Sec. 2. Chapter 574 of the City Ordinance of 1952, approved on 2.2. January 18, 1952, entitled "An Ordinance Authorizing the City Treasurer to invest General Funds in United States Government Securities" is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
