




Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a STOP sign along Mc Clellan Street at its' intersection with Chalkstone Avenue.

Disposition: Our survey of this intersection showed that it is a "T" intersection with only 6 vehicles entering and leaving Mc Clellan Street during the peak traffic hour. In addition this is a dead end street with no reported accidents on our files. This request is therefore denied.
