In reference to your letter of August 23, 1962 relative to the redemption of Lots 244 and 245 on Assessors Plat 16 located on Thayer Street, these lots lie within the Historic College Hill District boundaries, but not in the East Side Renewal Project or any present or proposed studies by the City Plan Commission or the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

Reference is made to Referrals numbered 836, 948, and 949 all requesting purchase of these lots for which no objection was offered, and to the Committee on Ordinances Referral No. 953 requesting a change of zoning from R-1 and R-3 of an area bounded by Roome Lane, John Street and Thayer Street to an R-4 zoning for which the City Council gave the petitioner leave to withdraw.

Provided the purchaser of these lots intends to use them in accordance with the present zoning and comply with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Providence, there is no objection offered in the selling of the above-mentioned lots.






