It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 31-3-4 of the General Laws in Chapter 31-3 entitled "Registration
2 of Vehicles" is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 31-3-4. Proof of payment of sales or use tax. -- Each person, before obtaining an
4 original or transferal registration for a motor vehicle in this state, must furnish evidence that any
5 tax due with reference to the motor vehicle under chapters 18 and 19 of title 44 has been paid in
6 accordance with regulations prescribed by the tax administrator, and on any forms that are
7 approved by the tax administrator and the state administrator of the division of motor vehicles.
8 The administrator of the division of motor vehicles will, when requested and after due hearing by
9 the tax administrator, suspend or revoke a motor vehicle registration of any person who fails to
10 pay any tax due in connection with the sale, storage, or other use of the motor vehicle pursuant to
11 chapters 18 and 19 of title 44.

12 The administrator of the division of motor vehicles shall also, after due hearing by the tax
13 administrator, suspend or revoke a motor vehicle registration of any person who fails to pay
