Approved September 15, 1967

WHEREAS, Major Edmund Henry Hornstein, late a resident of the Mount Pleasant area, a graduate of Mount Pleasant High School, class of June, 1952 and of Providence College class of 1956, while on active duty in Vietnam with his unit, the Second Battalion, 25th Infantry Division was mortally wounded in an attempt to rescue a wounded comrade, and

WHEREAS, the recipient of two posthumous awards, Two Bronze Stars and The Purple Heart, for valor and bravery, with complete disregard for his own safety Major Hornstein's service and supreme sacrifice for his country personifies the "esprit de corps" of our fighting men in Vietnam,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That in order to perpetuate the memory of this gallant member of the Army of the United States of America, His Honor Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the City Council do hereby designate that area, along the northerly portion of Mount Pleasant Park, utilized as a "Tot Lot", as Major Edmund Henry Hornstein Memorial Playground", and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Clerk is directed to transmit a duly certified copy of this Resolution to his widow Kathleen Harrison Hornstein.

REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL

Gentlemen:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency in accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 12 of Chapter 1375, as amended, of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved December 2, 1960; and Title 45, Chapter 32, Section 5 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, hereby reports concerning the proposed sale of real property within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park.

The Agency proposes to sell to Livermore and Knight Company, presently located in Pawtucket, R. I., a certain parcel of land situated within the Huntington Expressway Industrial Park. Said parcel of land, which has been delineated on the attached map, contains 683,892 square feet of land and will be sold for a total sales price of \$100,000.

Livermore & Knight Company is in the process of expanding their present operations. Preliminary plans submitted by the Redeveloper propose the construction of a 135,000 square foot building in two phases. Phase I proposes a 56,000 square foot building estimated to cost \$800,000 and will house a new \$1,000,000 Web printing press. This Web printing press will be the nucleus of the new addition to their present operation. Stage II proposes a 79,000 square foot building estimated to cost \$680,000. Initial employment of 50 is expected to increase after the construction of the second stage.

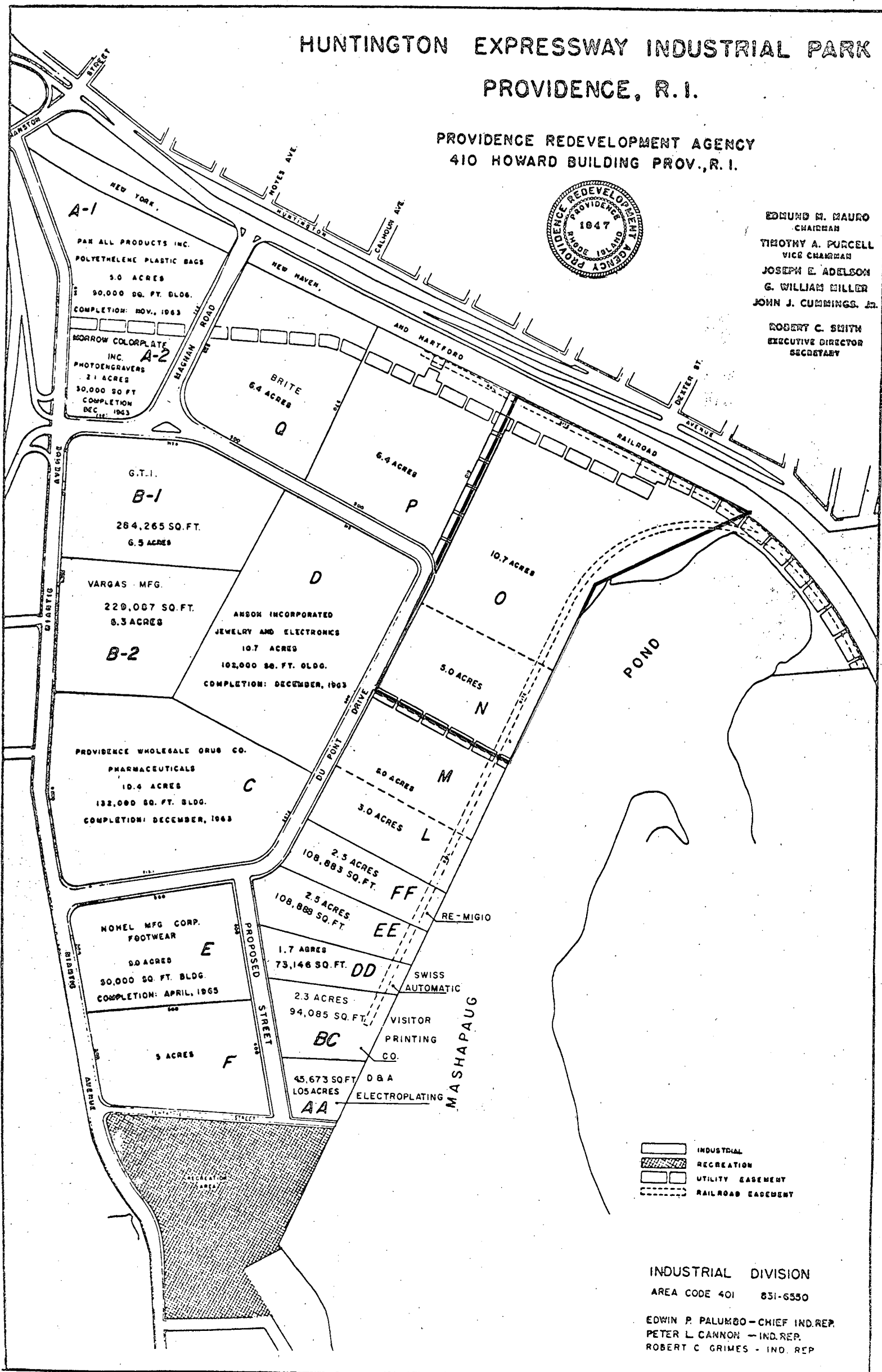
