AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PROTECTION, MAINTENANCE, REMOVAL AND PLANTING OF TREES IN THE PUBLIC STREETS, PARKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES AND TREE PROTECTION ZONES ON DESIGNATED PRIVATE PROPERTY UNDER DEVELOPMENT, ESTABLISHING THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS AND ESTABLISHING THE DIVISION OF GROUNDS MAINTENANCE SERVICES, AS THE AGENCIES PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE PROTECTION, MAINTENANCE, REMOVAL AND PLANTING OF TREES IN THE ABOVE MENTIONED PLACES, PROVIDING FOR THE MAINTENANCE OR REMOVAL OF TREES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WHEN THE PUBLIC SAFETY IS ENDANGERED AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS, AS AMENDED.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 23 1/2-41 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence is amended to read as follows:

- E. No person shall install steel grate or any facsimile or like substance within the confines of the ground area surrounding the base of the tree trunk.
- F. No person shall preclude or inhibit the percolation of water, nutrients and gaseous exchange necessary to a tree's survival by placement of any material which so precludes or inhibits within the tree well opening.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

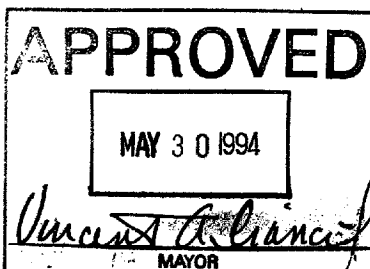
