RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is hereby authorized to transfer to Merit Oil Corporation a parcel of real estate consisting of approximately 25,281 square feet located at 396-400 Elmwood Avenue, Providence, Rhode Island, being further described as Assessor's Plat 49, Lot 568 for the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00), pursuant to the terms and conditions as have been imposed by the Committee on City Property, the City Council, the City Solicitor and His Honor, the Mayor.

These conditions shall include, but not be limited to, Merit Oil Corporation reaching an agreement with the City of Providence relative to upkeep of the premises and a financial contribution to the neighborhood for sidewalks, park maintenance, trees, etc.

WHEREAS, The integrity of all people who serve the City in the capacity of Judge, Board Member, Commission Member and Authority Member is of the utmost importance, and


WHEREAS, The Citizens of the City are placing their trust in these individuals to lead the City honestly and with integrity,
