WHEREAS, His Honor the Mayor and the Members of the City Council, who must attend official business in City Hall, frequently find it difficult to park their vehicles, particularly within close proximity of City Hall, and

WHEREAS, since official matters often must be attended to on short notice, the inconvenience of lost time, in finding legal parking spaces, could affect their deliberations of government business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Clerk, in conjunction with the Traffic Engineer, is requested to develop a Program whereby the Mayor and the Members of the City Council be granted parking privileges, within close proximity to City Hall, during regular business hours and for meetings of the City Council and of Committees thereof.
