AN ORDINANCE

**RELATING TO WORKERS
COMPENSATION INSURANCE
AND LICENSING**

Approved December 8, 2003

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

No license required under the provisions of this section shall be issued, transferred, or renewed by the Board of Licenses until such applicant certifies that it possesses insurance for workers' compensation coverage if the applicant for the license is required to maintain such coverage under Rhode Island General Laws §28-29-1, et. seq.

It is further made a violation of this ordinance to provide a false or fraudulent certification of workers' compensation coverage to the Board of Licenses and shall be grounds for the denial or revocation of any license issued, modified or renewed in reliance upon said certification.

A failure to maintain workers' compensation coverage or to notify the Board within five business days after receipt of any notice of termination, suspension or revocation of workers' compensation coverage shall be grounds for the suspension or revocation of the applicant's license.

Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to create or constitute a liability to or a cause of action against the City in regard to the issuance or non-issuance of any license for failure to provide evidence of workers' compensation coverage.

The Board of Licenses is directed to take appropriate actions, including altering the license application form, to require a certification and such other evidence as it deems appropriate of applicant's workers' compensation insurance coverage.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage.
