WHEREAS, Bill Abrahamson was brutally shot down while patrolling Roger Williams Park on October 12, 1995 and died soon thereafter on October 18, 1995 in Rhode Island Hospital,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That henceforth, Washington Park Square be known as "The William R. Abrahamson Memorial Square" in recognition of his dedication and commitment to the Washington Park neighborhood and to the Parks Department of the City of Providence.

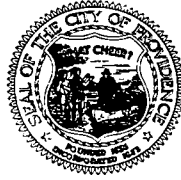
