Petition:

We the undersigned residents and property owners bounded by Lenox Avenue, Adelaide Avenue, and Atlantic Avenue from Broad Street to Elmwood Avenue protest the present heavy trucking condition, mostly on Adelaide Avenue, which disturbs our peace during the day and especially during the night by constantly disrupting our sleep.



WHEREAS, activity in civic and athletic forums did not take all of his time so that he gave abundantly to his church from which he rated the highest of respect.

BE IT THE RESOLVE of this Body that its Clerk cause a duly engrossed copy of this expression be transmitted to Mrs. James J. Corry.


