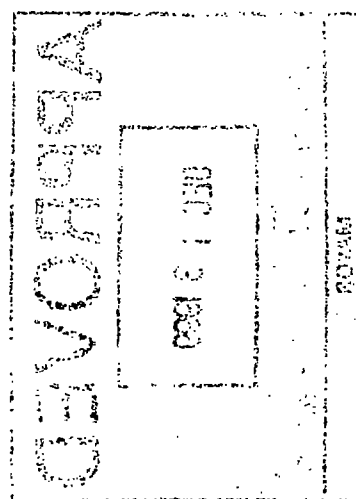

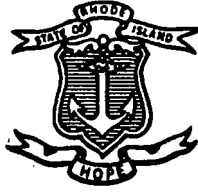

Dear Mr. Clement:

In response to City Council Resolution #730 approved December 13, 1999, and transmitted to the Department of Transportation, staff have reviewed the condition of the guardrail at the intersection of Service Road 4 and Seekel Street, Providence.

I would first apologize for the slow response; it took a little time for our field personnel to identify the specific location in question. However, they have found a damaged guardrail attached to a bridge which passes over the interstate highway system. The guardrail at this location appears to have been damaged by a motor vehicle impact, or by trucks in the area turning the corner sharply and "clipping" the guardrail with their rear tires.

In any event, we will have the guardrail at this location repaired as you have requested.
