No. 618 **AN ORDINANCE** To amend Ordinance #1999-13, No. 233 and in amendment of Chapter 21 Revenue & Finance by adding Article XI, Section 21-190 entitled "Tax Exemption for certain property owned by the Providence Redevelopment Agency".

Approved September 29, 2000

Be it ordained by the City of Providence: That the Code of Ordinances Chapter 21 Revenue & Finance be amended by adding the following:

"Article XI"

Section 21-190 Tax Exemption for certain property owned by the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

1. Certain real property acquired and owned by the Providence Redevelopment Agency which has been acquired for the development of the MET School shall be "exempt from taxation", pursuant to R.I. Gen. Law, Sec. I 45-32-40 of the General Laws in Chapter 45-23 entitled "Redevelopment Project", as amended.
2. 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.




