It is resolved by the General Assembly as follows:

RESOLVED, that the sum of \$225,000 dollars be and same of is hereby appropriated out of the money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal year ending (June 30, 1987) to be expended by the States Community Action Agencies to provide additional funding for Senior Citizens Transportation programs in the State of Rhode Island which have been established by various municipalities. The purpose of which is to provide expanded transportation service for elderly and handicapped citizens. This funding will be administered by the States Community Action Agencies and allow said agencies to include food shopping service. The State Controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the General Treasurer for the payment of such sum.

EXPLANATION

This bill would provide an additional (\$225,000) dollars in State Aid Community Action Agencies to provide elderly and senior citizen transportation for food shopping.
