Dear Tom,

I am writing to request your help and assistance to have No Parking on weekdays from 8:00 A.M. to 4 P.M. on the southern side of Regent Avenue from the corner of Walcott Street to the end of the OLP property.

This No Parking restriction is necessary because at the present time our three school buses have to discharge our students on the streets since they cannot enter our Parking Lot and exit on the other side because cars are parking on both sides of Regent Avenue and it is impossible for them to make the turn. The results are a hopeless jam on Regent Avenue and Lisbon Street while the buses are discharging students. The same situation occurs at 2:30 P.M. when school is dismissed. I might add that in the event of a fire the fire trucks would experience similar problems.

What I am seeking is the same restriction that exists on the other end of Regent Avenue for the Regent Avenue School and on Mt. Pleasant Ave. for Mt. Pleasant High School. I do not think the restriction should be on both sides as it is for the other schools one side would be ample.

I would be deeply grateful to you for any help you can give. I am sending a copy of this letter to Councilman Stravato since his son attends Our Lady of Providence.
