

This referral is a request to abandon an unnamed gangway from Cedar Street to Adie Street.


On an inspection and photographic survey it was found that the street in question was uncurbed, unpaved and graded down sharply from its intersection at Adie Street.

Re: Abandonment of Elm Street

Dear Vin:

In accordance with our telephone conversation of this date, I am writing to inform you that my client, Imperial-Armour-Rex Co. has arrived at a settlement with the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

As a result of this settlement, and after having had experts go over this entire proposition for us, we no longer have any objection to the petition for abandonment filed by the Redevelopment Agency. However, we have discussed the matter with the Redevelopment Agency and we must purchase the land from them prior to the abandonment so that after the abandonment one-half of the street adjacent to the land in question will practically revert to us. The Redevelopment Agency, through its attorney, Mr. McCarthy, has informed me that the deal cannot be closed before November 23, but that it may take a few more weeks. Consequently, I am requesting that you notify the Committee on Public Works that they take no action in this matter until they hear from me and the Redevelopment Agency to the effect that our transaction has been completely executed and we have taken title to the property which we are purchasing from them. As soon as that transaction has been completed, we will notify the Committee, through you, of the formal withdrawal of our objection to the petition for abandonment, and we will join in the petition of the Redevelopment Agency urging that the portion of the street in question be abandoned.

Incidentally, I have informed the Redevelopment Agency that I am writing this letter and I am sending a copy of it to the Agency. So that there may be no question in anyone's mind, the settlement referred to above is definite and positive, and all that



Dear Mr. Vespia:

On October 29, 1959, a hearing was held in the Council Chambers at the City Hall before the Committee on Public Works on a petition filed by the Providence Redevelopment Agency seeking the abandonment by the City of Providence of a portion of Elm Street, in said City. At that hearing, my client, Imperial Armour Rex Company, objected to said petition for abandonment at that time and after a lengthy hearing, the matter was continued pending further certain negotiations between my client and the Redevelopment Agency.

On November 13, 1959, I wrote to you with reference to these negotiations. On January 22, 1960, these negotiations were finally concluded by the execution of a deed from the Redevelopment Agency to my client of Lots numbered 65, 68, 69, 74, 75 and 104 on Assessors Plat 21 in the City of Providence. As a result of this transaction, my client now owns all of the land bounding on the northerly side of Elm Street for the entire length of the proposed abandonment.

My client is, therefore, withdrawing its objection to said abandonment and hereby joins in the prayer of the petition of the Providence Redevelopment Agency


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

the following named person, firm or corporation is hereby granted permission to erect, alter or use a building or structure at the location named herein for the sale of petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil and their products, compounds and components as described and shown in and on the application therefor and accompanying plat, all on file in the Office of the Department of Building Inspection subject to the conditions that said person, firm or corporation shall not violate any of the laws of the State of Rhode Island or any of the Ordinances of the City of Providence relative to the erection, use or occupation of said structure and that said person, firm or corporation shall not allow petroleum, kerosene, gasoline, coal oil or their products, compounds or components, to be conveyed over or across any sidewalk by means of any pipe or hose, and upon such special conditions as are hereby enumerated and further provided that the Director of the Department of Building Inspection may authorize minor changes in the structural detail of plans on file, viz:

WARD 4. CARLO ARLIA, 588-598 Branch Avenue, Plat 99, Lot 463, 3-4,000 gallon gasoline storage tanks and 1-500 gallon fuel oil tank, making a total storage capacity of 12,500 gallons upon the premises and 2 gasoline filling pumps.

The erection or location of any buildings or structures not shown on the original plat on file with the Director of Department of Building Inspection, or any change in the location of buildings or structures from that shown on said plat shall be deemed a violation of this permit.
