RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 1171

Approved December 14, 1979

WHEREAS, The enormous increase in the cost of Government coupled with a decline in productivity in certain sectors of the work force and inflation have placed great economic pressures on the City and its budget. The City is left with no alternative other than to seek to organize its Governmental agencies so that they may be better able to adapt to, and utilize, Government for new technological technology and innovation, and

WHEREAS, Useful technology can, and does, originate in various parts of the nation and throughout the world, and

WHEREAS, It is unlikely that the City Government will be able to learn about all advances in technology that can be beneficially utilized by it, and

WHEREAS, Local governments do not have the resources or facilities and are otherwise ill-equipped to keep pace with rapid technological changes and advances,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mayor appoint a special committee consisting of the Director of the City Plan Commission, members of the City Council, and members of the Mayor's staff to undertake a study concerning the use of technology, computers, and programming with a view toward cutting operation costs, improving city services, and such other matters as may result in more efficient and effective operation of the municipal government and its agencies.
