AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 7 OF CHAPTER 1984-54, APPROVED JULY 20, 1984, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLASSES OF POSITIONS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES, AND THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES IN CERTAIN CLASSES IN THE CITY DEPARTMENTS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1983-31, APPROVED JULY 10, 1983, AS AMENDED" RELATIVE TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY - PURCHASING.

Approved January 4, 1985

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Section 7 of Chapter 1984-54 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved July 20, 1984, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

"The number of employees in the Department of Public Property - Purchasing shall not exceed eleven (11). There shall be no more than:"

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

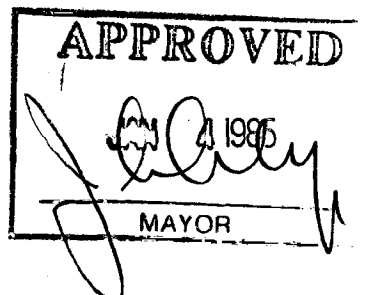



Gloria L. Lincourt, acting director of the division of purchasing, needs to establish an additional Clerk I position in her division.
