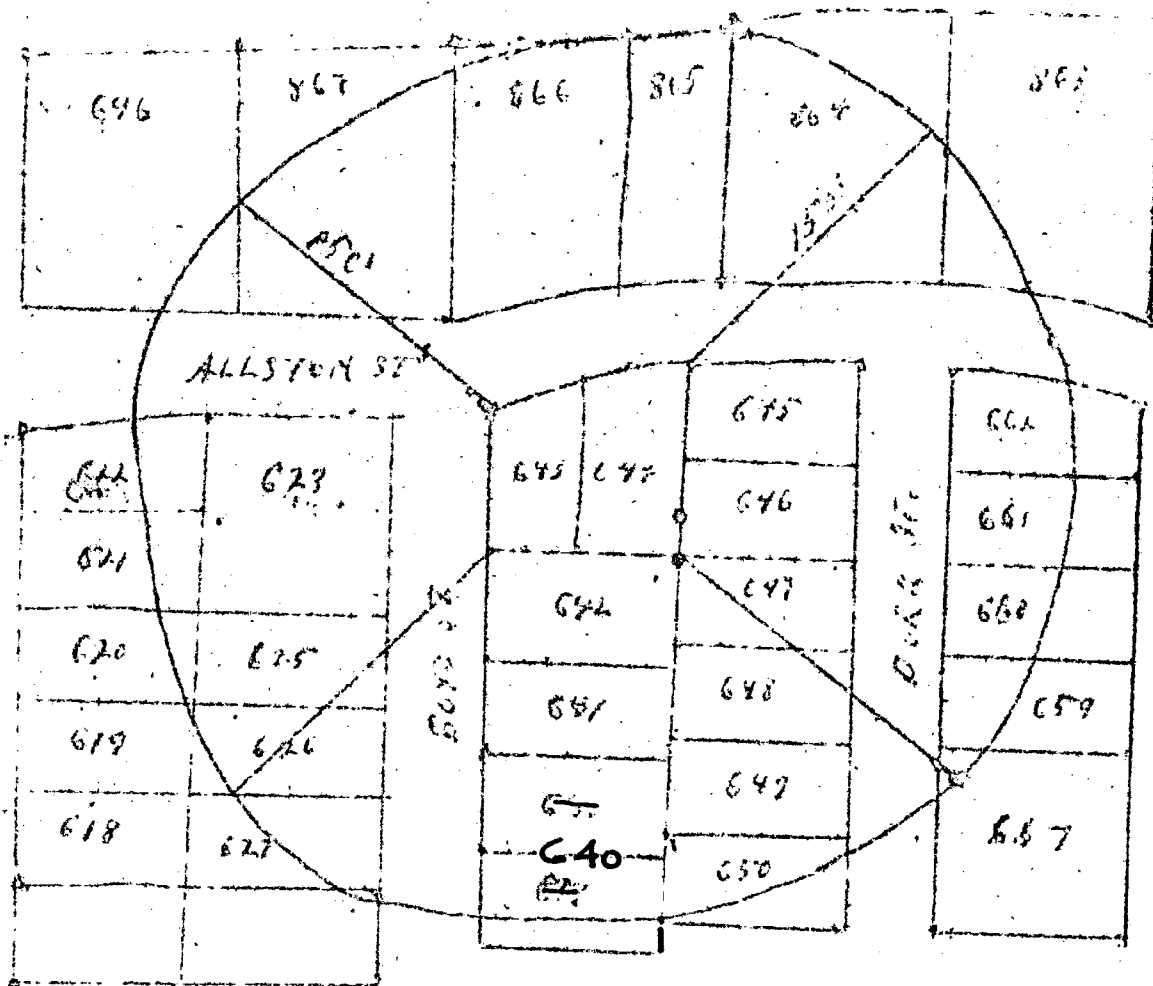

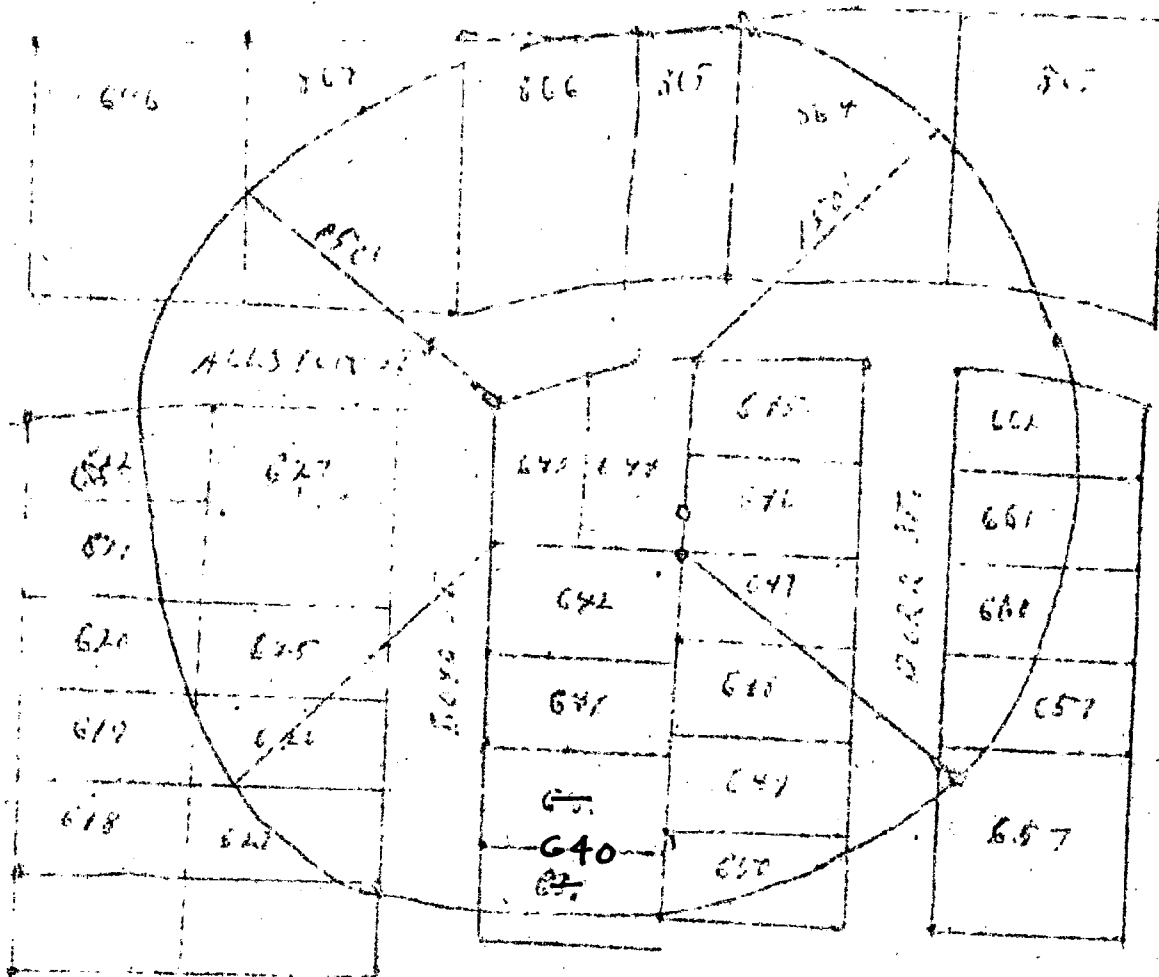
RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET

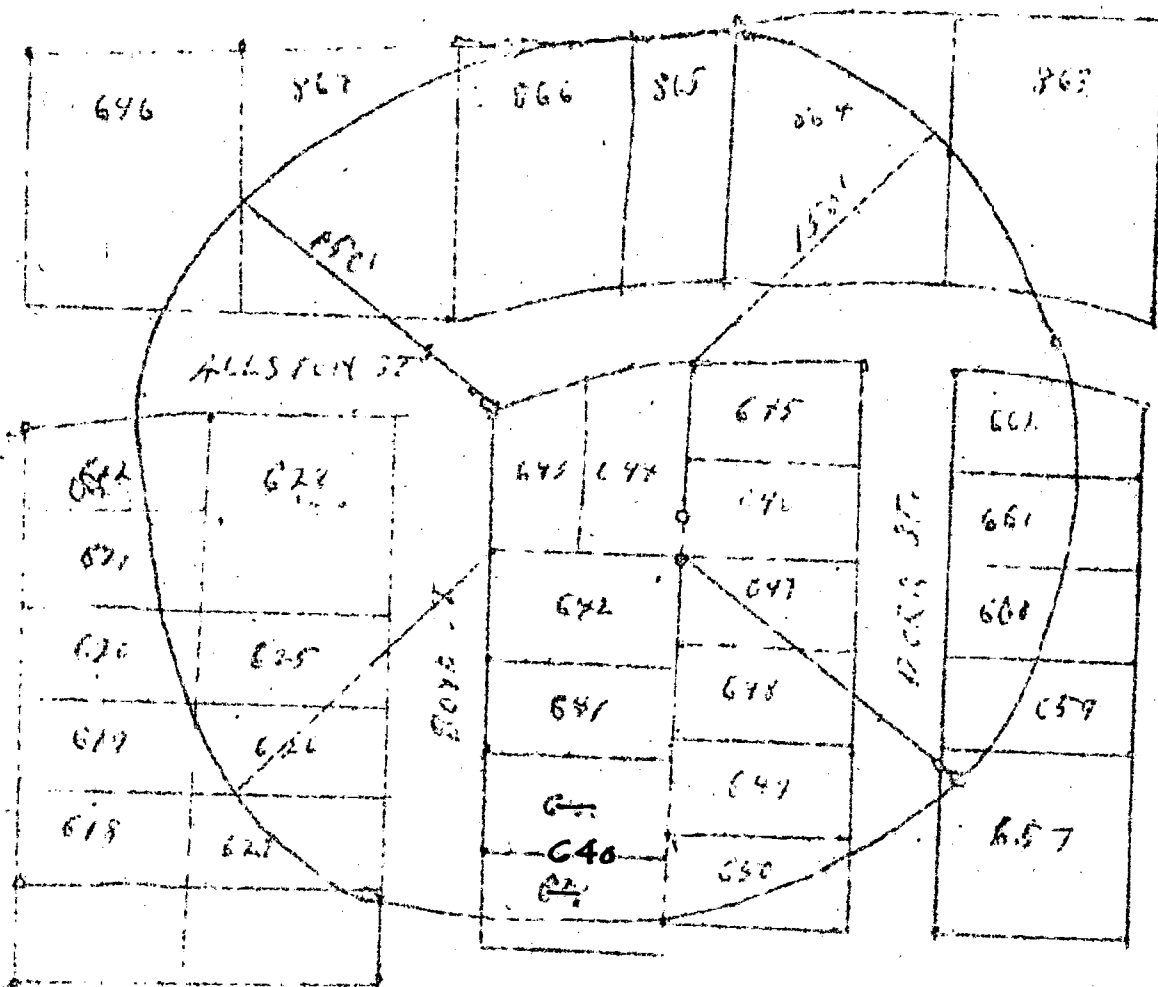
RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET

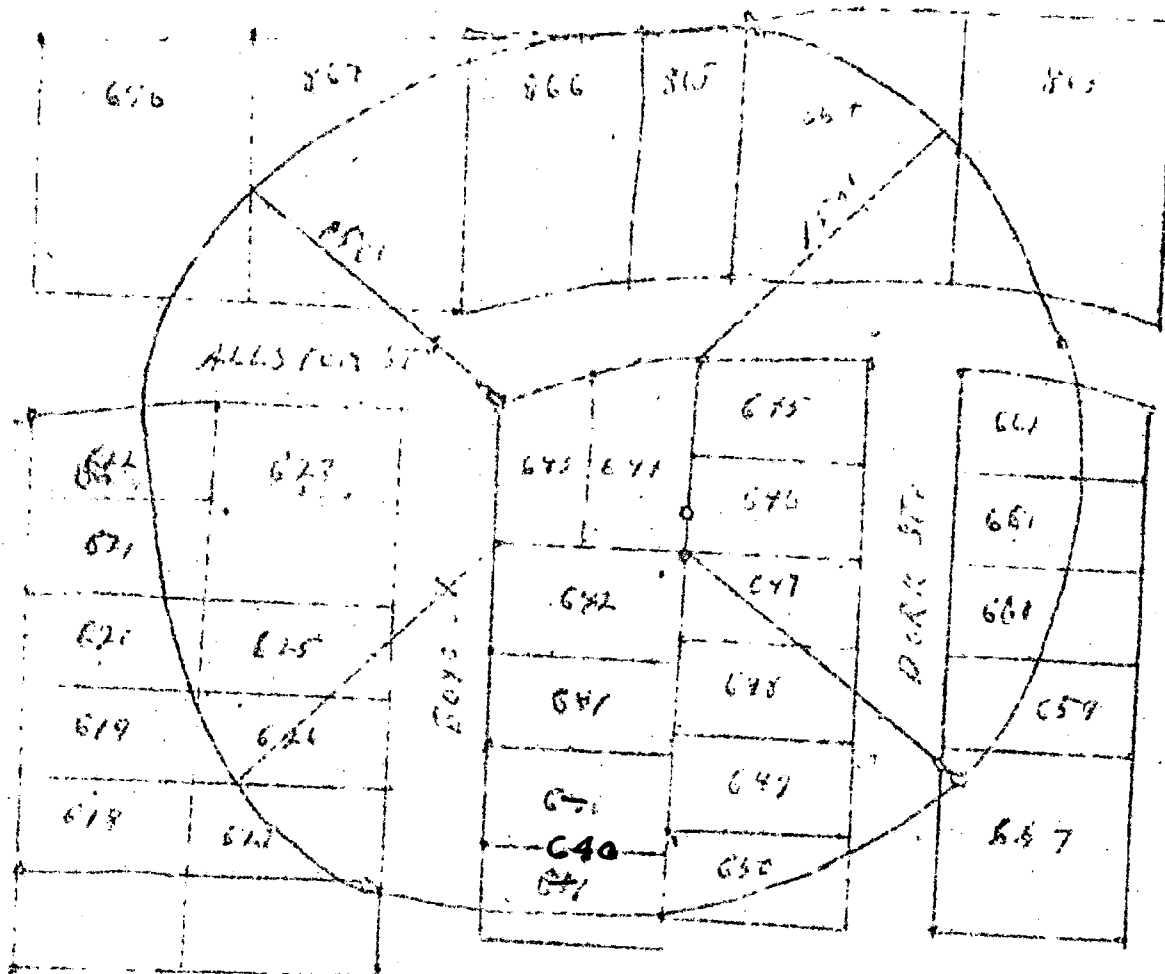


RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET

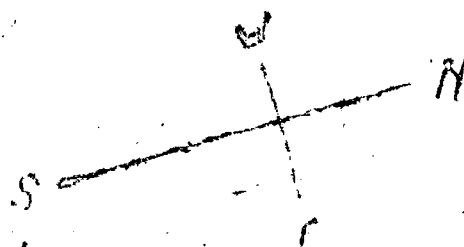


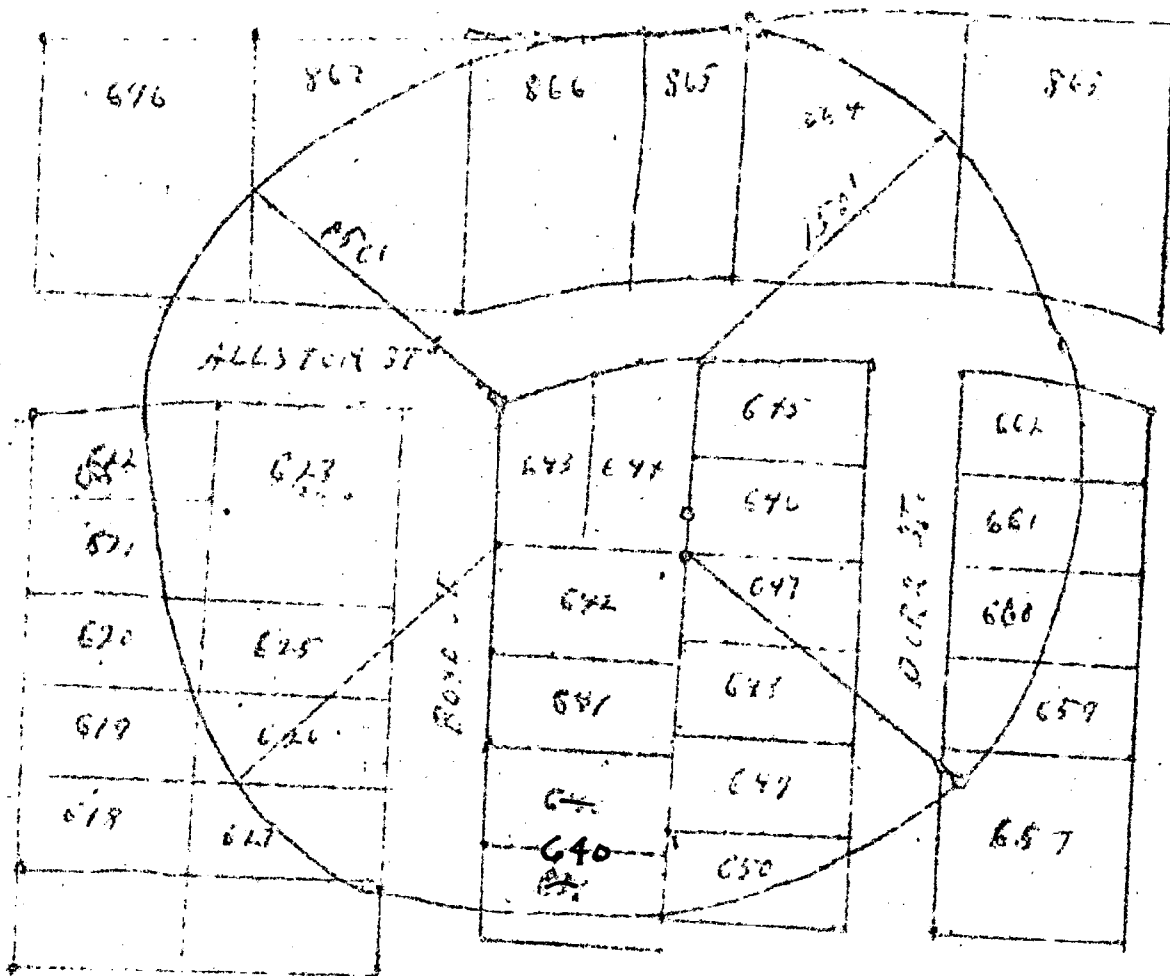


RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET

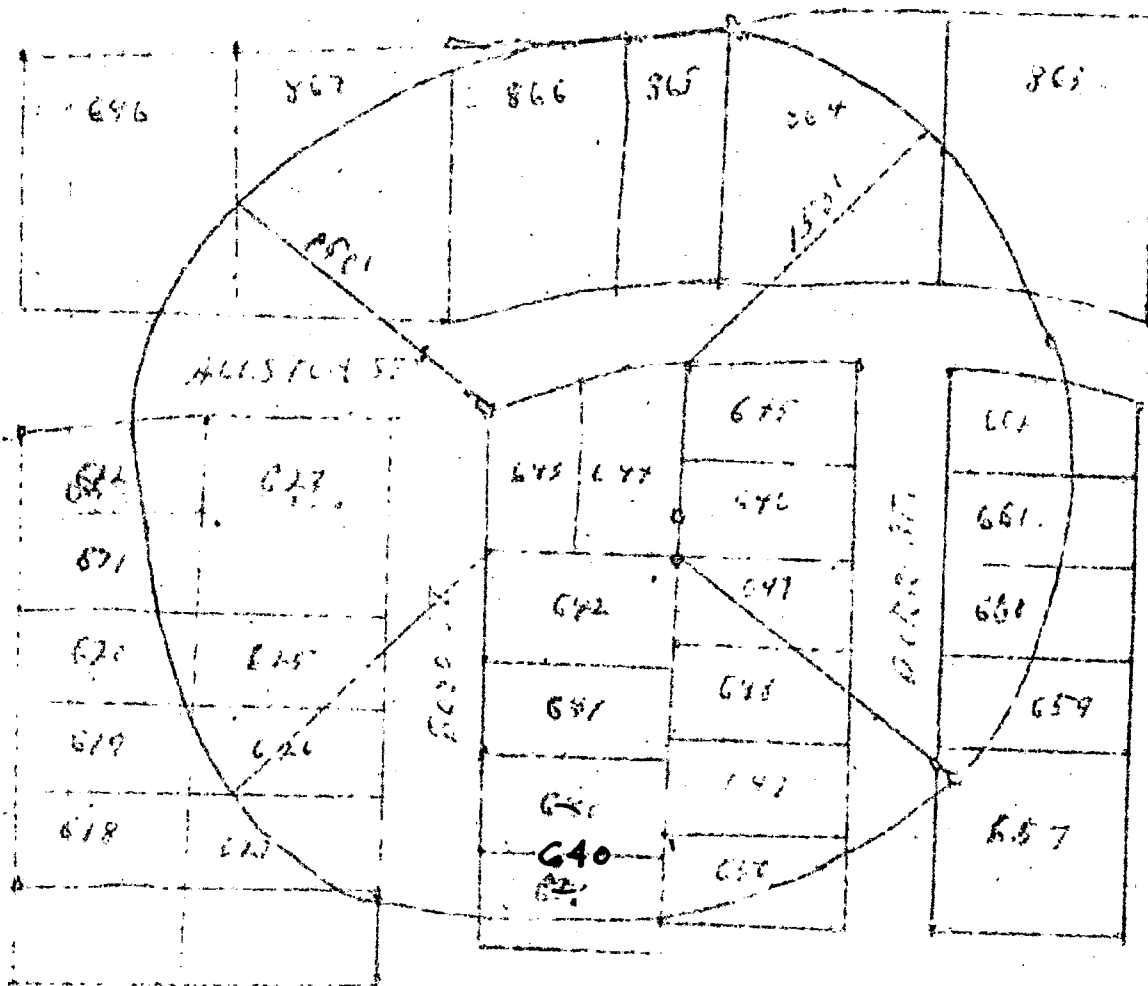
RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET

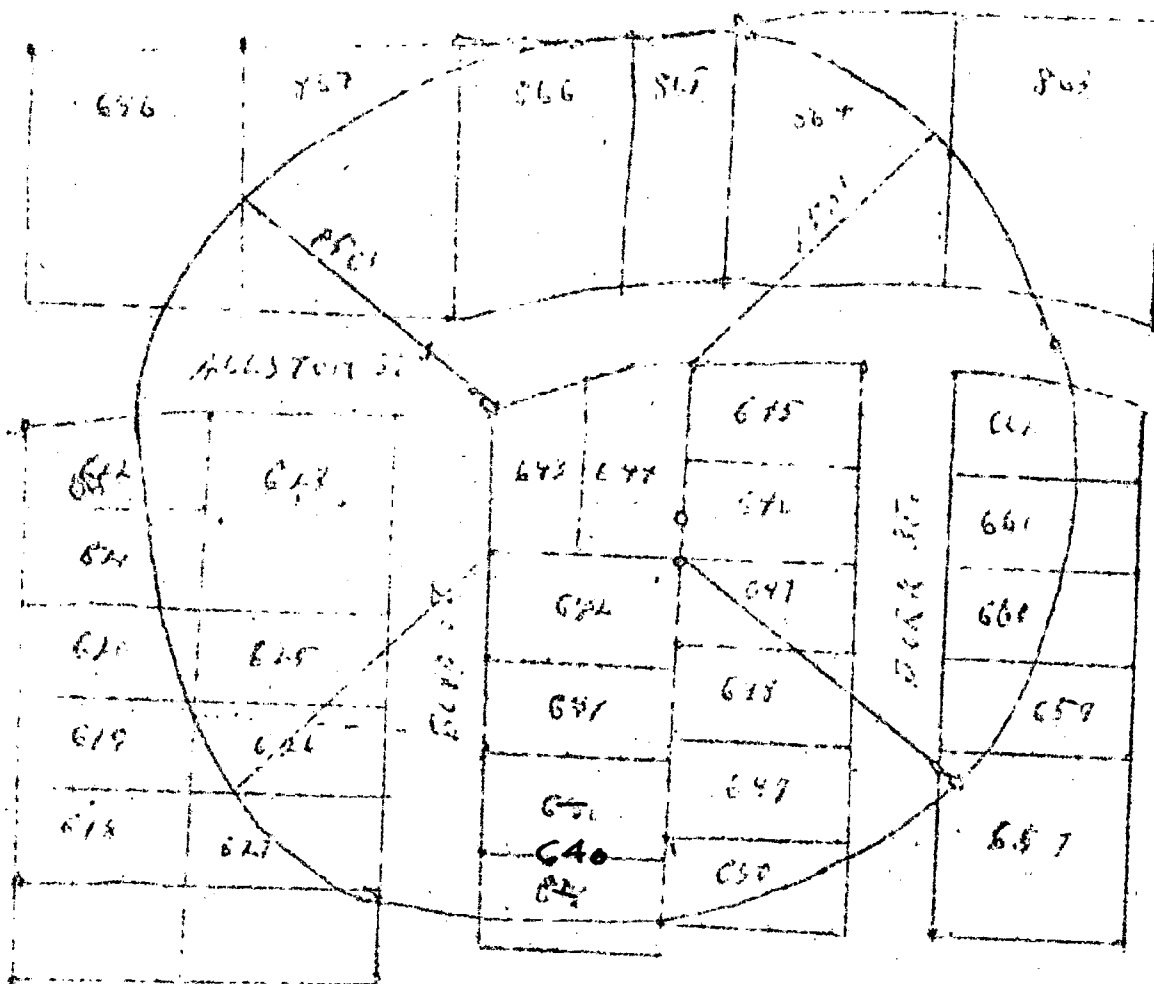
RADIUS PLAN FOR 38 BOYD STREET
