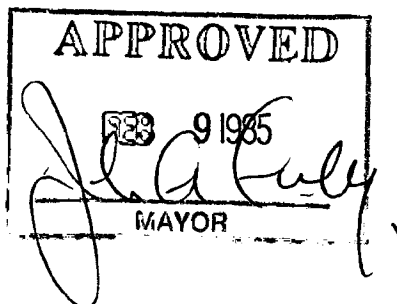

After a preliminary review of the employees in the Public Properties Department I respectfully request consideration of a pay change for one position.

I would request that the carpenter's pay be changed to \$17,514.38 which would be the midway point between laborer and licensed electrician.
