DEPARTMENT OF LAW ANNUAL REPORT

May 27, 2004

INTRODUCTION

This Report is provided to the City Council and the Mayor pursuant to Home Rule Charter Section 1201 (e) and Section 2-98 of the Code of Ordinances. Part I describes the organizational structure of the Department of Law, with attention to reforms implemented over the past year to improve service to the City and its departments.

Part II summarizes major accomplishments by the Law Department in fiscal year 2003-2004. These include improvement of services to both the School Department and the Department of Planning and Development, with concomitant diminished reliance on outside counsel; disposition of a substantial backlog of tax cases; and bringing a new level of transactional expertise to the table, facilitating such matters are the negotiation of new health care contracts with Blue Cross/Blue Shield and United HealthCare, and due diligence connected with the sale of the Providence Place Mall.

Finally, Part III of the Report describes significant case developments and important transactions closing during the fiscal year. It also gives data on cases currently pending in the Department with reference to Appendix A, listing all such cases by attorney.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

Management Team: A three-person management team leads the Law Department. City Solicitor Joseph M. Fernandez is the Chief Executive; he supervises the legal and administrative work of the Department; makes legal, policy and strategic decisions concerning work product; and serves as the liaison and chief counsel to the City Council and Administration. Deputy City Solicitor Adrienne G. Southgate supervises the daily operation of the office and is the attorney in charge of corporate and regulatory matters. She provides regular counsel to the City Council and the Departments of Planning and Development, Public Works and Parks. Senior Assistant City Solicitor Sara A. Rapport is the chief litigator, supervising the office's litigation and providing support to Assistants and Senior Assistants. She also oversees and provides regular counsel to the School and Fire Departments.

Senior Assistant City Solicitors: Alan E. Kornstein, William T. Smitherman, and Bruce D. Todesco maintain significant caseloads in the areas set forth below. In addition, Senior Assistant Todesco has oversight and training responsibility in the District Court, working with Assistant Catalano and others in the prosecution of misdemeanors.¹

Assistant City Solicitors: Kevin F. McHugh, Raymond Dettore, Frederick W. Stolle, Caroline C. Cornwell, Kenneth B. Chiavarini, Pamela B. Quigley, Olayinka Y. Oregduba, Steven L. Catalano and Michael Tarro have duties outlined below.

In general, the Law Department is encouraging attorneys to specialize in a substantive area of law. This specialization creates two related benefits for the City: it affords attorneys the opportunity to develop deeper knowledge and skill in legal fields that have become increasingly complex, and in so doing, provide better quality service to the City. Pamela Quigley, who serves as counsel to the School Department, and Kenneth Chiavarini, who advises City departments on labor and employment matters, are the clearest examples of this move toward specialization. Both of those roles were approved by the City Council in this fiscal year upon the recommendation of the Law Department. Certain legal areas overlap, yet for the most part, the Law Department's attorneys are maintaining individual portfolios reflective of a specific area of expertise. Assistant McHugh advises the Police Department; Assistant Stolle works with the City Council Finance Committee and the Finance Department; Assistant Dettore handles zoning and property matters; Assistant Cornwell handles appeals; Assistant Oredugba litigates housing and building code enforcement matters; Assistant Catalano handles misdemeanor prosecutions; and Assistant Tarro handles workers' compensation cases and juvenile offenders.

The specialization carries into the Senior Assistant ranks. Senior Assistant Smitherman is concentrating on tax and financial litigation; Senior Assistant Kornstein, on tort claims and litigation; and Senior Assistant Todesco, on overseeing the practice in District Court. Those newer to the practice of law look to these senior practitioners for advice.

Support Staff & Paraprofessionals: Sheila Sanchez, Carolyn Ranucci, Allison Chiaverini and Sharon Mulcahey comprise the outstanding support staff for the Law Department.

¹ Earlier this month, the District Court implemented a reform that will require the Law Department to provide an additional attorney in the District Court. Until this development, only one attorney was required for District Court work.

DEPARTMENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The Law Department has improved service significantly in at least three key areas: transactional advice, School Department work, and tax and financial litigation.

Transactional Advice: Every City Council committee and every City department has ongoing requirements for transactional assistance. The committees of the City Council, as well as individual members of the Council (particularly Ordinances Chair Rita M. Williams, Public Works Chair Terrence M. Hassett, Majority Leader Luis A. Aponte and Minority Leader David Segal), need assistance in researching and drafting ordinances and resolutions, including tax stabilization agreements. For some departments, such as Planning and Development, the review of contracts and leases, HUD documents, and research on bond documentation can be very complex and detailed. Parks and Public Works each provide a consistent volume of legal work, typically involving leases, easements and abandonments. Finance and Public Properties require assistance in contract negotiation and drafting.

The corporate and regulatory lawyers in the Law Department – particularly Deputy Southgate and Assistants Dettore and Stolle – have undertaken to staff all of the standing City Council committees as well as provide advice and assistance to the Council and individual Council members. They also staff virtually all of the City boards and commissions, as well as a number of operations boards (e.g., City Plan Commission, Historic District Commission, Downcity Design Review Commission, Planning Board, Zoning Board). This is an unparalleled level of service, for which departmental staff are particularly appreciative.

School Department: The work for the School Department is demanding. Education law requires good working knowledge of federal and state law in the following general areas: constitutional law (including First Amendment speech and religious expression), labor law, employment law (including harassment), disability and accommodations law, student rights law, and statutory law (Title 16 of Rhode Island General Laws). As of the close of fiscal year 2003, the School Department relied entirely upon outside counsel, specifically the law firm of Powers, Kinder & Keeney, Inc.² The cost of such outside counsel was substantial. From March 31, 2002, when Powers, Kinder & Keeney began work for the School Department, through May 31, 2003 (last available bill for fiscal year 2003), the firm charged the City nearly \$180,000.00. This work did not even include trials or significant courtroom time, but was comprised exclusively of representing the School Department at Board meetings and providing daily advice on myriad matters.

² Effective October 1, 2003, that firm disbanded and merged into a new firm called Little, Medeiros, Kinder, Bulman & Whitney.

In this fiscal year, with the strong encouragement of the City Council, the Law Department assumed the duties previously performed by outside counsel. Senior Assistant Rapport and Assistant Quigley now regularly counsel the School Department on internal and School Board matters and issues before the Rhode Island Department of Education (RIDE). They work with the School Department's Human Resources Office, attend and advise the School Board at its biweekly meetings, and perform all of the Department's legal work, with the exception of advising on labor, special education, and workers' compensation matters.³ They have played a key role in the School Department's development and implementation of a standardized process for conducting suspension and termination hearings under Title 16 of the Rhode Island General Laws. As part of this effort, they have planned and participated in training sessions over the year for the School Board and school administrators. Assistant Quigley's efforts in particular include appearing before RIDE, the Rhode Island Commission for Human Rights, the Rhode Island Unemployment Compensation Board, and the American Arbitration Association. In sum: the Law Department now represents the School Department in state and federal court, and before most administrative tribunals.

Tax Litigation: In early 2003, the Law Department inherited a tax litigation backlog that was nothing less than extraordinary. Over 500 cases pending in Superior Court had been languishing for years, in many instances, for over a decade. In addition, approximately 1,800 administrative challenges to the revaluation of December 31, 2000 lay dormant in the Assessor's Office and before the Board of Tax Assessment Review. The Law Department, led by Assistant Stolle, initiated a two-part effort to eliminate the backlog. First, it helped to streamline the review process in the Assessor's Office, and thereby disposed of nearly all administrative appeals; it did so by helping to establish procedures, educating the staff on the criteria to employ to resolve such matters, and providing daily advice on specific cases.

Second, Assistant Stolle and Senior Assistant Smitherman resolved nearly 300 of the 500 cases pending in Superior Court. The settlements reduced the City's exposure and liability by fifty percent (50%), on average, with time payments. Among the most significant settlements was that consummated with US Gen (Manchester Street Power Plant) on the issue of "double taxation." In addition to resolving the taxation issues, the Law Department negotiated a long-term tax treaty with US Gen worth \$33,000,000.00 payable to the City in equal installments over five years.

³ Attorneys Jeffrey Kasle and John Mahoney serve as outside counsel on labor and special education matters, respectively. The cost of Attorney Kasle's services for School Department work from July 1, 2003 through April 30, 2004 was \$12,648.65. The cost of Attorney Mahoney for work from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, was an estimated \$20,000.00. Attorney Paul Gionfriddo is employed by the School Department to represent the Department in all workers' compensation disputes. He is paid a salary of \$39,500.00 for approximately twenty hours of work per week.

Approximately 100 new tax challenges have been filed in Superior Court during fiscal year 2004, with the result that, as of May 2004, approximately 300 cases are pending. Assistant Stolle and Senior Assistant Smitherman each continue to carry a heavy docket of tax cases, as well as other matters. The Law Department recently began to conduct "training sessions" to educate the Assessor's Office in its handling of appeals to the Board of Tax Assessment Review, and to give feedback on questions and concerns the office staff may need to have addressed.

THE DEPARTMENT DOCKET

Corporate and Regulatory Matters: Among the significant achievements on the regulatory and transactional side of the Law Department are the following:

1. Settlement of three consolidated cases regarding utility regulation, involving every major utility in the City, which had been pending before the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission since 1997.
2. Development of a set of statewide street restoration standards which are shortly to be submitted to the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission for ratification, having already received the approval of the Rhode Island Public Works Association and the Rhode Island League of Cities and Towns.
3. Creation of a new draft municipal Code of Ethics.
4. Settlement of the I-183 power lines case, involving the relocation of Route I-195 and the adjacent high-voltage power lines over India Point Park.

Litigation: Assistant Kevin McHugh litigated two major cases for the Department and the City this year. The first was Young v. City, in which the estate of Sergeant Cornel Young, Jr. sued the City and individual defendants in federal court for alleged constitutional violations in connection with the death of off-duty Officer Young. The court granted the City's Motion for Summary Judgment in November 2003. The plaintiff has appealed. Department Assistants McHugh, Rapport and Cornwell are defending the matter, with briefing due before the United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit this summer.

The second case handled by Assistant McHugh was Rivera v. City. In spring 2004, the federal court granted the City's Motion for Judgment on the Pleadings. The Rivera estate has appealed the district court ruling to the First Circuit; again, Department Assistants McHugh, Rapport and Cornwell will defend the case on appeal.

Senior Assistants Rapport and Todesco have litigated several employment-related matters in federal and state court. Senior Assistant Kornstein prevailed on summary judgment in a series of cases filed in state court in which the City and the State contested


responsibility over the maintenance of certain streets, the care of which Kornstein successfully argued was entrusted to the State pursuant to statute. Assistant Chiavarini was victorious in state court on summary judgment motions that resulted in a precedential ruling that the City could use monies payable under the Providence Retirement Act to offset amounts paid or payable under the workers' compensation law in a third-party action for personal injury. He also prevailed on a directed verdict in a jury trial involving a bicyclist and City vehicle. Assistant Oredugba successfully defended the City in a lawsuit alleging that the City must provide alternative housing to tenants forced to leave substandard buildings, despite significant efforts by the City to assist those tenants through both direct service and litigation against the owner-landlords in housing court. And Senior Assistant Smitherman has recouped over \$100,000.00 in monies for details performed by the Fire and Police Departments – details which, until his efforts, had remained uncollected.

Over the past several months, the Department closed roughly 200 old and inactive cases dismissed by the Superior Court or otherwise resolved or rendered inactive. The Law Department is now overhauling its case management system. The process in place for fiscal year ending June 2004 has been in existence for many years; to date, however, it has proven unworkable and outmoded. In addition, over the years, cases have been transferred from one attorney to another, without adequate oversight as to who had custody of files and was tending to the litigation.

The plan for putting this system in order is as follows: beginning in June 2004, the Department will transfer all case information into a new database, to have the following categories: (1) Case Name, with notation showing whether case is "active" or "inactive" or "closed"; (2) Court Number (with notation of type of court, e.g., Federal, Superior, District, RICHR, AAA); (3) Law Department Number; and (4) Case Type, e.g., Tort, Contract, Constitutional, Employment, Labor, Tax, Other. When a case "closes" in fiscal year 2005, it will remain listed so that by the end of the forthcoming fiscal year, the Department will be able to assess the actual number of cases closed over the year.


