It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 39-21.5 of the General Laws of
- 2 Chapter 39-21.1 entitled "911 Emergency Telephone Number Act"
- 3 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sections:
- 4 g.) Any city or town which can demonstrate the ability to
- 5 provide 911 services, as defined in section 39-21.1-3, shall be
- 6 granted the authority to do so.
- 7 h.) In the event that a city or town does provide the 911
- 8 service, all fees and revenues relating to the municipality's
- 9 service area will be forwarded to the respective city or town.
- 10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
