



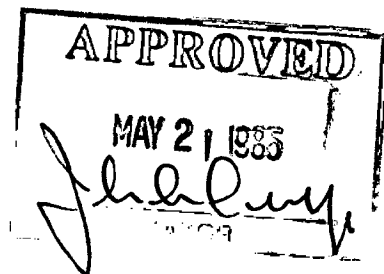

RESOLUTION NO. 328, APPROVED May 21, 1985

Resolved, That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of "No Parking" signs along Lakeside Street.

RESOLUTION NO. 329, APPROVED May 21, 1985

Resolved, that the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of "VEHICLES PROHIBITED FROM DRIVING ON PARK PROPERTY" signs along the Central High School Ball Field.

Disposition: Granted. We will manufacture two (2) "ALL VEHICLES PROHIBITED" signs and install these signs on the Central High School Ball Field.

RESOLUTION NO. 331, APPROVED May 21, 1985

Resolved, That Winslow Street be established as a one-way street in a southwesterly direction, from Greene Street to Broad Street.
