

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 437

Approved May 9, 1979

RESOLVED, THAT WHEREAS, the City of Providence may be eligible to receive funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Innovative Program and under the Federal Homestead Program; and

WHEREAS, the applications for funding the respective programs shall be filed with the Department of Housing and Urban Development not later than May 7, 1979 for the Innovative Program, and May 15, 1979, for the Federal Homestead Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That the City Council of the City of Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, hereby authorizes the City of Providence, through its official representative, the Mayor, to file the said applications for the Innovative Program and the Federal Homestead Program, and to do all acts necessary to successfully acquire said funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all moneys received by the City of Providence from the Department of Housing and Urban Development shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of the Innovative Grant Program and the Federal Homestead Program of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

RE : Authorization Resolution from City Council

We are preparing applications to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for additional funds under the following programs.

- 1) Innovative Grant Program. An application is being prepared in conjunction with SWAP that could bring up to \$500,000 to the City if approved by HUD, application due May 7th.
- 2) Federal Homestead Program/^{thousand} This program would enable us to get several hundred/dollars in Section 312 money to homestead HUD owned properties in the City of Providence, application due May 15th.

Both of these programs, if acceptable to HUD, would substantially improve our ability to increase home ownership in the City and to rehabilitate abandoned property.

We need a resolution authorizing the Mayor to apply for these funds. Charlie Mansolillo will introduce it tomorrow night.

He needs a draft resolution for presentation to the Democratic Caucus this evening. Charlie will get back to me at 4:15 P.M. for the resolution.
