No. 840 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TWO PUBLIC WORKS REVOLVING FUNDS.

Approved October 16, 1964

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: There are hereby established two new Public Works Revolving Funds to be respectively entitled :

1. "PUBLIC WORKS REVOLVING FUND-STORES"

and

2. "PUBLIC WORKS REVOLVING FUND-EQUIPMENT"

SEC. 2. The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to transfer all assets and liabilities now existing in the following three revolving funds to the new "Public Works Revolving Fund-Stores":

1. "Public Works-Construction and Maintenance, Shop and Stores Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 659 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, 1952;
2. "Public Works-Sewer Construction and Maintenance, Shop and Stores Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 660 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, 1952;
3. "Public Works-Sanitation, Shop and Stores Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 661 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, ~~1962~~ 1952.

SEC. 3. The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to transfer all assets and liabilities now existing in the following three revolving funds to the new "Public Works Revolving Fund-Equipment":

1. "Public Works-Construction and Maintenance, Equipment Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 659 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, 1952;
2. "Public Works-Sewer Construction and Maintenance, Equipment Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 660 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, 1952;
3. "Public Works-Sanitation, Equipment Revolving Fund" as established by Chapter 661 of the City Ordinances, approved September 5, 1952.





RESOLVED,

THAT permission be granted to Davol Rubber Company a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, in accordance with the provisions of an act of the General Assembly passed at the January Session, A. D. 1947, entitled "An Act to Enable Davol Rubber Company to Build and Maintain a Bridge over and across the Intersection of Point Street and Eddy Street in the City of Providence," to construct and maintain a bridge of one or more decks over and across the intersection of Point Street and Eddy Street in the City of Providence for the purpose of connecting the buildings of Davol Rubber Company, located on diagonally opposite corners of said intersection, and of providing passageways between said buildings. Provided, that every part of such bridge, except the posts or supports thereof, shall be at least twenty (20) feet above the surface of said streets.

The permission hereby granted is upon the condition that said bridge shall be constructed under the supervision and control and to the satisfaction of the Office of Building Inspection of the City of Providence, and the City Engineer of said City; and upon condition that said bridge shall be removed upon 90 days' previous notice from the City Council whenever in the opinion of said City Council the public interest may require its removal; and upon the further condition that there shall be no advertising or lettering displayed thereon; and upon the condition that in case the City of Providence shall at any time hereafter be authorized to assess abutting owners for the private use and occupation of the public highways, the passage of this Resolution shall in no manner affect the right of the City to charge and collect rent for the use of

said Eddy and Point Streets by said Davol Rubber Company, and for maintaining thereon said bridge; and upon the condition that said Davol Rubber Company shall hold and keep said City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified from and against loss, cost, damage, payment and expense on account of any injuries to persons or damage to property for which said City may become liable on account of the construction, maintenance, use or repair, or neglect properly to maintain or repair, or any defect of said bridge over and across said Eddy and Point Streets, unless the wrongful act or negligence of said City, its officers or employees shall cause such injury or damage as is mentioned aforesaid; and upon condition said Davol Rubber Company before commencing the work of building said bridge shall file its bond in the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.) dollars in form satisfactory to the City Solicitor to hold and keep said City harmless, safe and indemnified as aforesaid, and it is agreed by the acceptance hereof, that the amount of said bond shall not be construed or held to limit their general obligation to hold and keep said City harmless, safe and indemnified as aforesaid; and also upon condition that said Davol Rubber Company shall, before commencing the building of said bridge, file with the City Clerk its written acceptance of the terms and conditions of said Resolution and its agreement to perform and observe all said terms and conditions.

PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body

WHEREAS, your petitioner has two factory buildings located on diagonally opposite corners of the intersection of Point and Eddy Streets, in the City of Providence, and,

WHEREAS, the increased business of your petitioner requires a greater utilization of and expansion into one of said buildings presently used mainly as a warehouse, and

WHEREAS, such increased utilization and expansion will require a much greater flow of materials and personnel between said buildings, and

WHEREAS, the passage of such materials and personnel across said intersection at street level would create a substantial interference with the normal traffic through said intersection and would be hazardous for said personnel and would prevent the operation of your petitioner's business at a level of efficiency sufficient to warrant such expansion, and

WHEREAS, your petitioner desires to construct between said buildings and across said intersection a bridge which would accomodate the passage of said personnel and materials and avoid the hazardous and undesirable condition specified above, and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Rhode Island has passed an act, Chapter 1833 of the Public Laws, January Session 1947, entitled "An Act to Enable Davol Rubber Company to Build and Maintain a Bridge Over and Across the Intersection of Point Street and Eddy Street in the City of Providence," which act authorizes and empowers the construction and maintenance of such a bridge upon such terms and conditions as may be described by the City Council of the City of Providence.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner respectfully petitions your honorable body to pass a resolution granting permission to your petitioner to build and maintain a bridge across the intersection of Eddy and Point Streets from a building located on Lot 310, Plat 21 to a building located on Lot 313, Plat 21, a distance of one hundred fourteen feet for the purpose of connecting said buildings of your petitioner located thereon, said bridge to be constructed in accordance with detail drawings upon their approval by the City Engineer and the Office of Building Inspection of the City of Providence, the bottom of such bridge, except for the posts or supports thereof, to be at least twenty feet above the surface of said streets.

THAT DAVOL RUBBER COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Rhode Island with a principal place of business in the City and County of Providence in said State, as principal, is holden and bound to the CITY OF PROVIDENCE, a municipal corporation, in the full sum of FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.) to the payment of which well and truly to be made we hereby bind ourselves and our successors and assigns firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH THAT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Providence by its Resolution numbered 644, approved on October 16, 1964, has granted permission to Davol Rubber Company to construct and maintain a bridge over and across the intersection of Point Street and Eddy Street in said City of Providence for the purpose of connecting the buildings of Davol Rubber Company located on diagonally opposite corners of said intersection, and

WHEREAS, said permission was granted upon condition, among other conditions, that said Davol Rubber Company before commencing the work of building said bridge shall file its bond in the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.) to hold and keep said City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified as set forth in said Resolution, and that the amount of such bond shall not limit its general obligation to hold said City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified as aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, if Davol Rubber Company, its successors and assigns, shall hold and keep the City of Providence harmless, safe and indemnified from and against loss, cost, damage, payment and expense on account of any injuries to persons or damage to property for which said City of Providence may become liable on account of

the construction, maintenance, use and repair or neglect properly to maintain or repair or any defect of said bridge over and across said Eddy and Point Streets, unless the wrongful act or negligence of said City, its officers or employees, shall cause such injury or damage, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and effect.


