WHEREAS, the Providence Community Action Program, Inc., the anti-poverty agency of the City of Providence, is the grantee for federal and state allocations for the Support of the poor of our City, and

WHEREAS, the citizenry of the City of Providence directly benefits from the programs sponsored through the Providence Community Action Program, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the City of Providence is required to commit local resources to supplement federal and state allocations to the local anti-poverty program,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, that the City Council appropriate the Principal and Interest of the Fund known as "City of Providence Anonymous Donation for the Support of the Poor" (5-652) on deposit in the Citizens Savings Bank to the Providence Community Action Program, Inc, and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, that Resolution of the City Council No. 457, approved August 6, 1962 depositing Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) to a Special Account known as "Anonymous Donation for the Support of the Poor Account" is hereby rescinded.
