Dear Council President:

The Providence City Charter requires that the Mayor submit his budget to the City Council no later than 60 days prior to the new fiscal year. In an attempt to submit that budget at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Council, I requested that the budget be placed on the April 19 docket.

However, I have been informed by the Director of Administration that because the School Budget process is incomplete and certain essential information on health care costs is pending, there will be a delay in the completion of the City's budget.

Therefore, I am requesting that the City Council postpone the presentation of the 1990-1991 City Budget until Tuesday evening, May 1, 1990 at 7:00 P.M. when I shall request a Special Council meeting be convened.
