Dear Madam Clerk:

Pursuant to Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, we are, this day, calling a Special Meeting of the City Council to be held Monday, June 24, 1985 at 5:00 o'clock P.M. in the City Council Chamber, City Hall for the purpose of acting upon the following:

An Ordinance Amending the Appropriation Ordinance Chapter 1984-53, approved July 20, 1984, by transferring the sum of Seven Hundred Three Thousand Forty-Six Dollars (\$703,046.00) from Retirement Fund to Council Contingencies, Item 1.

An Ordinance Establishing a Revolving Fund for the 350th Anniversary of Providence in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) within the Mayor's Office.

An Ordinance Amending the Appropriation Ordinance Chapter 1984-53, approved July 20, 1984, by Transferring Various Sums of Money within Various Departments.

An Ordinance Amending the Appropriation Ordinance Chapter 1984-53, approved July 20, 1984, by Transferring the Sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$12,500.00) from Sewer Construction and Maintenance Payroll Account (1-005-11-001) to Sewer Construction and Maintenance Item 269 Construction and Maintenance Supplies (1-005-11-269).

An Ordinance Amending the Appropriation Ordinance Chapter 1984-53, approved July 20, 1984, by Transferring the Sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) from (1-018-01-211) Public Property; Motor Fuel to (1-018-01-501) Public Property; Office Equipment and Furniture.

An Ordinance Providing for the Assessment and Collection of 1985 Taxes in a Sum not Less than One Hundred Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$107,500.00) and Not More than One Hundred Nine Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$109,500,000.00) being based on One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 1985-86 Fiscal Year Tax Collection.




An Ordinance Establishing a Compensation Plan for the City of Providence and Repealing Chapter 1984-55, approved July 20, 1984, as Amended.


