It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of those sums awarded to attorneys for the plaintiffs as set forth in the judgment of U.S. District Court C.A. 82-0358P, C.A. 82-0368P and C.A. 82-0383P and to U.S. First Circuit Court of Appeals relating to the declaration of unconstitutionality of P.L. 82, chapter 405. The general treasurer shall make payment to the attorneys of record in the sum of the judgments of June 4, 1984 and December 5, 1984 plus interest from the date of judgment and plus any other additional attorney's fees, interest, and cost accrued on the appeal of said case as approved by either U.S. District Court or U.S. Court of Appeals for the First Circuit.


Dear Rose:
