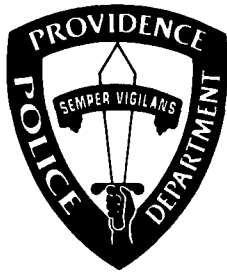

When looking to our Address Management Systems we do not have a Bloom Street listed for the 029 zip code area. Therefore I have to assume it is a paper named street only with no delivery at this time. To say whether the street name of DeConcilis Way would present a problem for the US Postal Service I would have to know the zip code for which this street is located. With this information we could provide a more educated response. If this street will not have mail delivery the Postal Service would not oppose the resolution as presented.
