Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has investigated the request contained in Council Resolution No. 460 dated September 7, 1956, for the installation of "Stop" signs on Rugby Street at Autumn Street on Gallup Street at Rugby Street and on Colfax Street at Rugby Street.

The result of the investigation at these three locations indicate an extremely low volume of traffic using all three, and at two of the intersections there has been no reported accidents since January, 1951. At the other location there has been only two accidents since January, 1951.

In view of this excellent accident record and of the extremely low volume, it is the considered opinion of this department that no "Stop" signs are needed at these locations at this time.

The Traffic Engineering Department has investigated the request for the installation of a "Stop" or "Yield" sign on Luna Street at its intersection with Branch Avenue as requested by City Council Resolution No. 459 dated September 7, 1956.

In view of the arterial nature of the traffic on Branch Avenue, the Traffic Engineering Department is designating Branch Avenue as a "through" street from North Main Street to Charles Street, and all side streets intersecting Branch Avenue between those limits not now controlled will be controlled by "Stop" signs.
