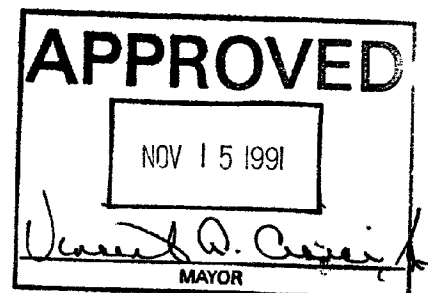
WHEREAS, We have all seen newsreels of other countries where huge pictures of popular leaders are hung from public buildings and carried through the streets by devoted followers, and

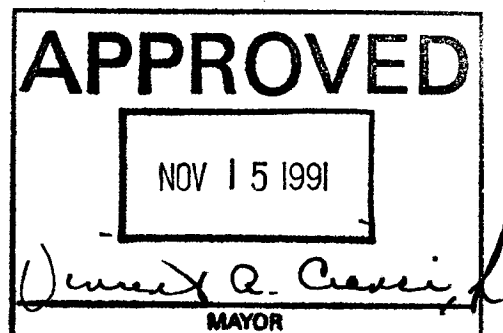

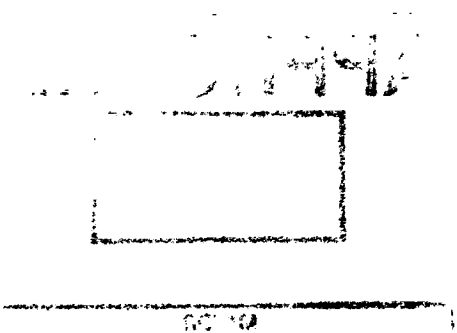
