WHEREAS, "Corporal Thomas P. Conlon, Jr., Memorial Park," bounded by Union Avenue, Kentwood, Waverly and Sorrento Streets, is one of the few open areas, within the City of Providence, devoted to and frequented by people seeking recreational diversion, and

WHEREAS, the use of such area for other than its recreational purpose, would be in conflict with the original intent of its use, such as requested by the Providence School Department, that the City transfer the same as the site of the proposed West Broadway Elementary School,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor the Mayor and the Honorable City Council are hereby respectfully requested to deny that request and refrain from conveying that area designated as "Corporal Thomas P. Conlon, Jr., Memorial Park," bounded by Union Avenue, Kentwood, Waverly, and Sorrento Streets, to the Providence School Department for the proposed construction of the West Broadway Elementary School and to further use their good offices to insure its continued use as a recreational area.
