

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 495

Approved September 13, 1991

WHEREAS, There have been numerous complaints from the area residents who live in and around Lockwood Plaza and Whitmarsh Apartments, of burglary, theft and drug dealings, and

WHEREAS, The tenants are in fear of their safety and potential loss of property because of the ongoing criminal element which has increased in recent months, and

WHEREAS, The assignment of Police Officers to patrol these apartments would be in the best interest of the community as a whole, and

WHEREAS, The Chief of Police, or his designee shall assign Police Officers to patrol the said apartments, and

WHEREAS, The officers so assign shall protect and keep the peace when necessary, and communicate with the tenants on a daily basis and gather any and all possible information that would be pertinent for the possible apprehension of those individuals who have made living in these apartments miserable, and

WHEREAS, The Mayor, Chief of Police, Tenants and area representatives shall form a calendar to meet monthly in order to bring these problems under control.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That His Honor the Mayor and the Providence Police Department shall work together with the people of the area to make life more pleasant at these apartment buildings.
