WHEREAS, November Eleventh has heretofore been celebrated in the United States of America as Armistice Day in commemoration of the cessation of World War I on November 11, 1918, and

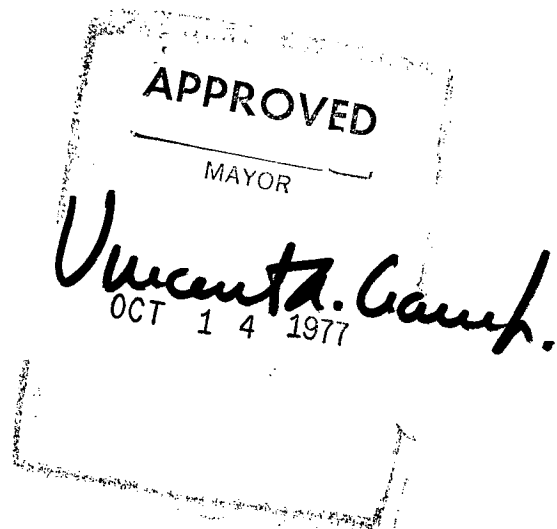
WHEREAS, in rearranging the 1977 calendar year, Armistice Day is scheduled to be celebrated on Monday, November 7, 1977, thus causing some confusion in its celebration and has the disapproval of Veterans of World War I and of Organizations of Veterans of World War I,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in order to restore in the State of Rhode Island and the celebration of the end of World War I, on the Eleventh Hour of the Eleventh Day of the Eleventh Month of 1918, the City Council of the City of Providence, does hereby endorse House Bill 76-H 7861, being, "An Act Relating to Veterans Day".

JANUARY SESSION, A. D. 1976

AN ACT Relating to Veterans Day.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

Section 1. Section 25-1-1 and 25-1-6 of the general laws in chapter 25-1 entitled "Holidays" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs:

"25-1-1. GENERAL HOLIDAYS ENUMERATED.—

* * *

Provided however, that commencing in the year 1977, Armistice day shall be known as Veterans day and shall in said year be celebrated on November 7, in each subsequent year thereafter, said Veterans day shall be celebrated on November 11.

"25-1-6. WORK ON HOLIDAYS PROHIBITED—
EXCEPTIONS—TIME AND HALF.—

* * *

Commencing in the year 1977 said Armistice day shall thereafter be known as Veterans day and the

above provisions shall thereafter apply to said Veterans day.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
