RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 799

Approved December 23, 1977

WHEREAS, certain conditions now exist at the New Samuel W. Bridgham Middle School, which are found to be a great inconvenience to the students, and

WHEREAS, the boys' and girls' shower rooms are inadequate for usage; a kitchen having cost Eighty Thousand (\$80,000.00) Dollars is inoperable; Twenty Nine Thousand (29,000) Square Feet of Carpeting is to be Cleaned with One vacuum cleaner; the boys' and girls' locker room does not have a hot water spigot for the hosing down of the floor together with many other conditions which are found to be inoperative,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Providence hereby requests the School Committee investigate the above specified conditions at the New Samuel W. Bridgham Middle School, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said School Committee submit a report to the Committee on Public Welfare as to when the existing conditions will be rectified.
