


Dear Councilman Payne:

Under date of March 21, 1967, we received an official memorandum from the Department of the City Clerk regarding a petition under consideration by your Committee regarding the abandonment as a public highway Sherburne Street from Allens Avenue to Poe Street. After reviewing the distribution records of this department, we find that we have an 8"-6" cast iron main in that section of Sherburne Street being considered for abandonment. The depreciated value of these facilities totalled \$1,658.72.

We wish to call to the Committee's attention the fact that a building occupied by the International Harvester Company receives a 6" fire supply from the main in Sherburne Street. If they desire to continue with a fire service to protect this property, they will have to arrange to make an application for a new service that would have to be installed from the main in Allens Avenue. They will be compelled to pay the department a service connection charge and make arrangements to make the necessary interior piping changes within the building to conform to the Rules and Regulations of the Water Supply Board.

The petitioner should be advised of this required change in their fire service connection and we respectfully request that your Committee withhold final action on this matter until the petitioner pays the City Collector \$1,658.72 covering the depreciated value of our facilities. We are filing a bill in this amount with the City Collector's Office.


Dear Councilman:




