AN ACT

I. AMENDMENT OF SECTION XII OF CHAPTER 590 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS, 1866, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE POLICE COURT OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Clause 10 of Section XII of Chapter 590 of the Public Laws, 1866, as amended by Section 4 of Chapter 1446 of the Public Laws, 1929, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Clause 10. A person charged with a violation of any rule, regulation, resolution or ordinance relating to parking of vehicles and notified in writing by a police officer to appear on a day and hour stated in such notice to answer such charge before the police court, instead of personally appearing in court, may in person or by one duly authorized by him in writing appear before the clerk of said court, admit the truth of said charge and pay to said clerk such fine as the city council shall from time to time by resolution or ordinance establish as a fixed penalty for such violation. Appearance, admission and payment shall be made at the office of said clerk during the office hours of said clerk within five days of such notification, and failure to appear within said time shall be deemed a waiver of the right to dispose of such charge without personal appearance in court. The payment of the fine to the clerk in the manner herein provided shall operate as a final disposition of such charge and such proceedings shall not be deemed criminal. The notice above provided shall indicate the offense charged and shall also contain such information as will enable the person charged to take advantage of the provisions of this clause. The right to dispose of such a charge without personal appearance in court may not be exercised by any person who in any consecutive period of twelve months next preceding such charge, has been three times in the aggregate adjudged guilty by said court of any violation relating to parking of vehicles or has admitted the truth of charges made against him, under the provisions of this clause."

SEC. 2. Said Section XII of said Chapter 590 is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following clauses:

"Clause 11. The City Council shall have exclusive power to provide for the punishment of any person violating any rule, regulation, resolution or ordinance relating to parking of vehicles by a fine of not less than one (\$1) dollar, nor more than twenty (\$20) dollars, except as limited by Chapter 1630 of the 1947 Public Laws, and for the punishment of any person committing any other traffic offense within the jurisdiction of the police court by penalties not to exceed those authorized by Section 4, Chapter 832 of the 1940 Public Laws."

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL
