RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 456

Approved October 14, 2005

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That His Honor, the Mayor, is authorized to grant easements, as delineated on the accompanying plan entitled: "Providence, RI Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064782 dated September 30, 2005" on, over, under, through, across and upon land owned by the City of Providence ("Grantor") to the Narragansett Electric Company ("Grantee"). Said easements shall be granted specifically upon the following provisions:

1. Said easements shall be utilized only for the installation and maintenance of high and low voltage transmission and distribution lines and for the transmission of intelligence by any means, now existing or hereafter devised, lines or towers or poles or both or any combination of the same with wires and cables strung upon and from the same (any of which may be erected and/or constructed at the same or different times), together with all guy wires, foundations, anchors, antennae, braces, fittings, buried ground wires and any other equipment or appurtenances reasonably required (collectively hereinafter referred to as the "Facilities"), including without limitation such temporary footbridges, causeways, and ways of access, if any, as may be necessary for the convenient construction, reconstruction, installation, repair, replacement, maintenance, operation, use, inspection and patrolling of the Facilities over, under, through, across, and upon land owned by Grantor located in Providence, Providence County, Rhode Island (hereinafter the "Easement Area"). The Easement Area constitutes 387,665 square feet, more or less, as shown on the plan which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference and more fully described in Exhibit A hereto;

Also, the perpetual right and easement from time to time, without further payment therefor, to (i) clear and keep cleared by physical, chemical, or other means the Easement Area of trees, underbrush, buildings, structures, and obstructions both above and below grade (the first clearing may be for less than the full width and may be widened from time to time to the full width); (ii) renew, repair, replace, add to, and

otherwise change the Facilities and each and every part thereof and all appurtenances thereto and the locations thereof within the Easement Area; (iii) pass and repass with vehicles and equipment along the Easement Area; and (iv) pass and repass with vehicles and equipment along the Grantor's Land and adjoining lands to and from the Easement Area to the extent necessary, as determined by Grantee in its sole discretion, for Grantee's exercise of the rights herein granted and conveyed. Grantor and Grantee acknowledge that Grantee's rights under this Grant of Easement are subject to (i) the relocation of I-195 as planned by the Rhode Island Department of Transportation ("RIDOT") and (ii) the continuing operation of the relocated I-195. The locations of Grantee's transmission towers on the Easement Area shall be as shown on the plan which is attached hereto.

2. It is intended by the parties that the rights and easements granted and conveyed herein constitute commercial easements in gross for the benefit of Grantee, its successors and assigns, and the parties agree that these provisions shall run with the Grantor's Land and shall inure to the benefit of and bind the heirs, legal representatives, successors, and assigns of the respective parties. The easement or a memorandum of same shall be recorded by Grantee in the Office of Land Records for the City of Providence. It is the intention of the parties that the rights and easements granted and conveyed to Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall be assignable in whole or in part and that they shall be divisible among two or more owners, as to any rights created, granted, and conveyed hereunder, so that each assignee or owner shall have the full rights and privileges herein created, granted, and conveyed, to be owned and enjoyed by either in common or severally.

3. Grantor, for itself and its heirs, successors, and assigns, hereby covenants and agrees with Grantee, its successors and assigns, that (i) no acts will be permitted by Grantor within the Easement Area which are inconsistent with the rights granted herein; (ii) no permanent or temporary buildings, structures, or obstructions other than those planned as part of the relocation of I-195 will be erected or constructed above or below grade within the Easement Area other than Grantee's Facilities without first obtaining in each instance Grantee's prior written approval, which approval will not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned, or delayed; and (iii) the Grantor shall not excavate or fill or

otherwise change or alter the present grade or ground level of the Easement Area other than as planned as part of the relocation of I-195 without obtaining in each instance Grantee's prior written approval, which approval will not be unreasonably withheld, conditioned, or delayed.

4. Said easements shall be subject to a right of reverter/right of reversion in the event that the situs of the easement is no longer utilized for the aforesaid purposes.

5. Grantee shall execute an indemnification and hold-harmless agreement with the City of Providence. Said agreement shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

6. Grantee shall supply the City of Providence with an insurance policy naming said City of Providence, its agents, officers, servants and employees as additional-named insureds in a sum not less than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) which policy shall be approved by the Department of Law of the City of Providence.

7. It is the intention of the Grantor to grant to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, all the rights and easements aforesaid and any and all additional and/or incidental rights needed to construct, reconstruct, repair, renew, replace, add to, maintain, operate, patrol, use, inspect and otherwise change, for the transmission and distribution of high and low voltage electric energy and the transmission of intelligence, the Facilities in, on, over, under, across, upon, and through the Easement Area, and the Grantor hereby agrees to execute, acknowledge, and deliver to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, such further deeds and instruments as may be necessary to secure to them the rights and easements intended to be granted and conveyed herein to Grantee, its successors and assigns.

8. It is agreed that the Facilities shall remain the property of Grantee, its successors and assigns, and that Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall pay all taxes assessed thereon.

9. Such other terms and conditions as may be reflected in the record and minutes of the City Council Committee on Public Works and/or as may be deemed appropriate by the Mayor or the Department of Law.

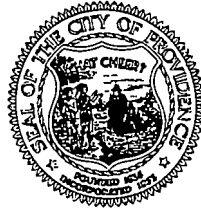

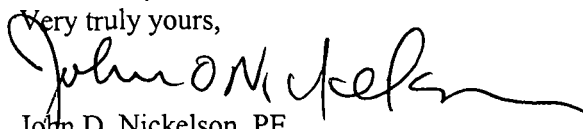
It is noted that there is NO SEWER EASEMENT required for said project. Total square footage is 127,840 ±.

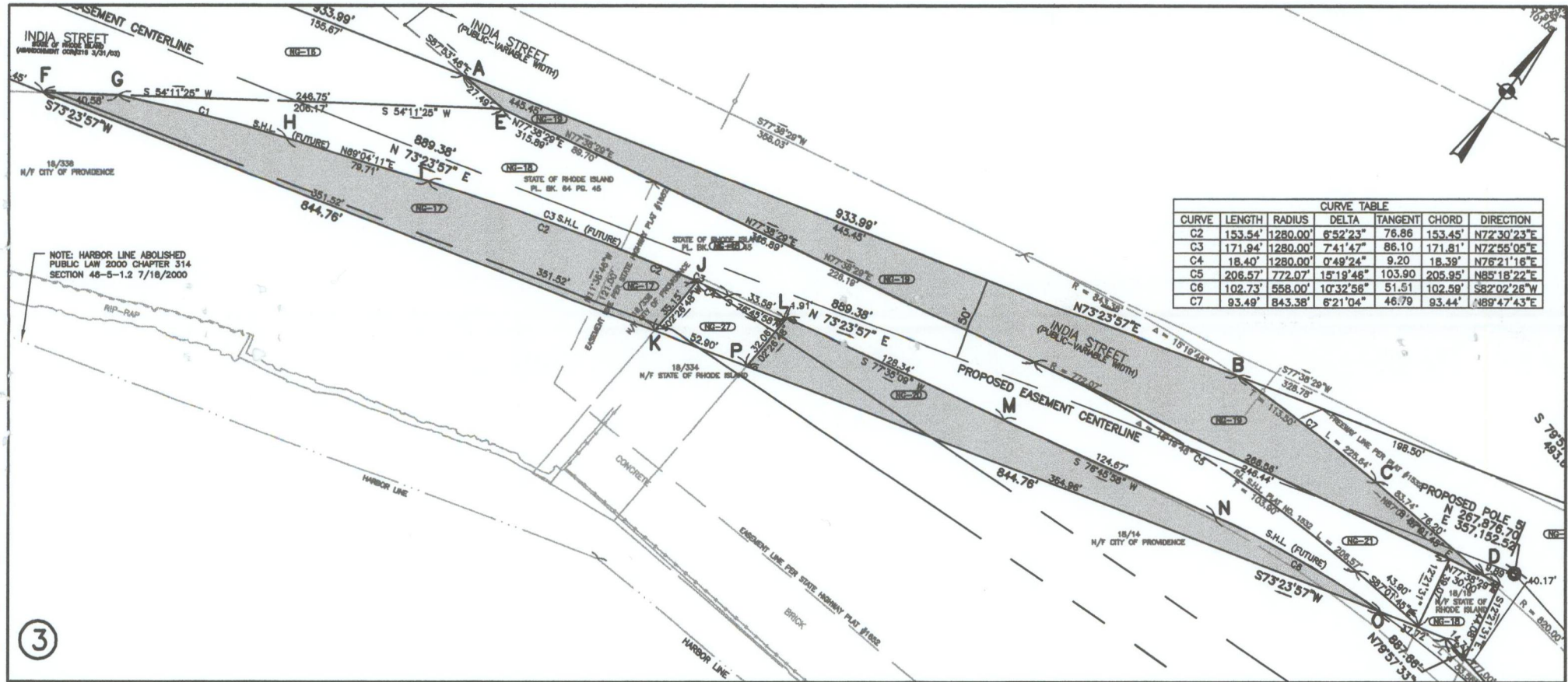

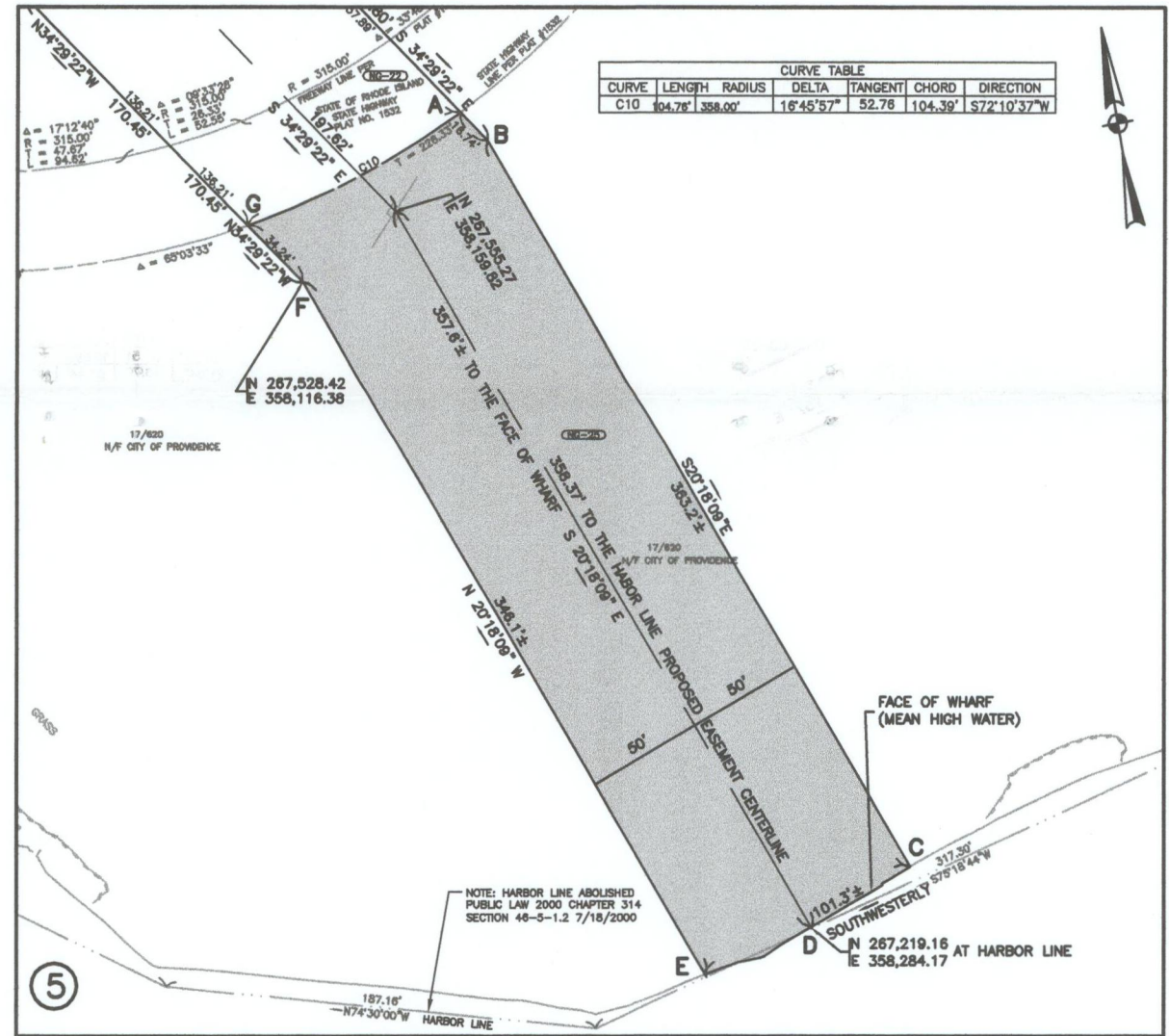
NOTE: Shaded area (A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H-I-J-K-A) indicates proposed transmission line easement.

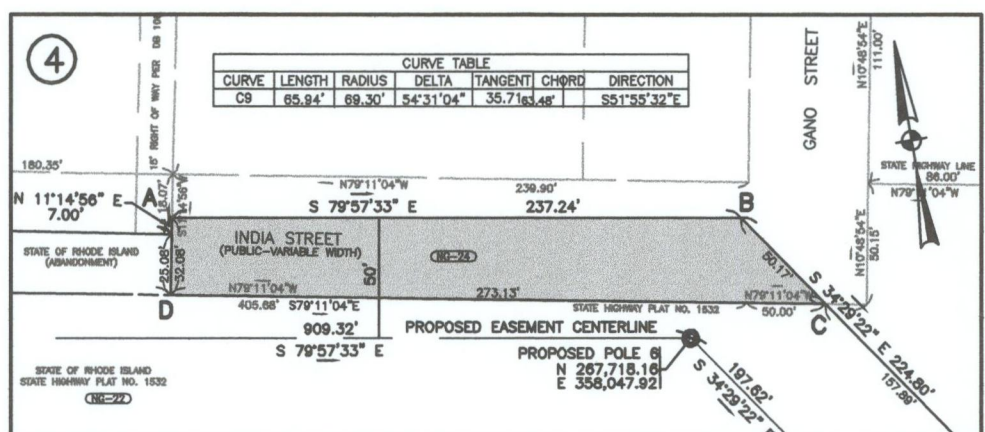
NOTE: Shaded area (A-B-C-D-A) indicates proposed transmission line easement.

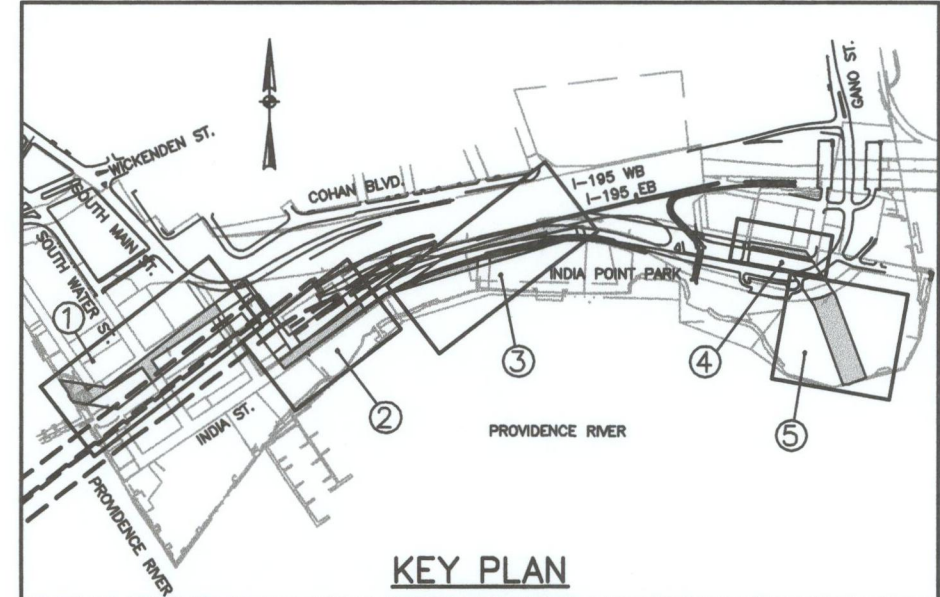

PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body

The Narragansett Electric Company ("Narragansett" or the "Company") respectfully petitions the City Council to grant to Narragansett permanent easements for an overhead transmission line in Fox Point and India Point as explained in detail below.

In April 2003, Narragansett filed an application with the Energy Facility Siting Board (the "EFSB") for approval to relocate Narragansett's existing E-183 115kV transmission line (the "E-183 Line") in order to accommodate the Rhode Island Department of Transportation's I-195 relocation project (the "I-195 Project.") As part of its filing, Narragansett proposed an overhead relocation which included the reconstruction of the transmission line crossings of the Providence and Seekonk Rivers.

The Cities of Providence and East Providence and the Rhode Island Attorney General objected to Narragansett's proposal and the parties have settled the case by Agreement dated May 25, 2004 (the "Settlement Agreement") which was approved by the EFSB on October 29, 2004. In re: The Narragansett Electric Company – E-183 155 kV Transmission Line Relocation Project, Docket No. SB-2003-01, Report and Order (Order No. 54, October 29, 2004).

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the parties agreed that Narragansett would reconstruct the E-183 Line in two phases. Phase I is the portion of the E-183 Line between the east bank of the Providence River and the vicinity of its proposed pole number 7, located southeast of the Radisson Hotel near India Street. Phase I is to be relocated overhead to allow RIDOT to proceed with the I-195 Project, according to its schedule.

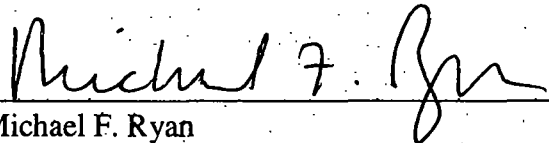
The parties also agreed that Narragansett would develop a route and design for the underground relocation of the E-183 Line from Franklin Square on the west bank of the Providence River to the east side of the Seekonk River which includes Phase I (the "Underground Alignment"). If the parties are able to obtain funding, property rights and permits for the Underground Alignment, Narragansett will rebuild this portion of the E-183 Line underground, and remove the Phase I overhead line.

In order to construct Phase I of the E-183 Project, Narragansett needs easements across City streets and other property owned by the City of Providence between the Providence River and the Seekonk River. Attached are plans prepared by Bryant Associates, Inc. for Maguire Group, Inc. entitled *The Narragansett Electric Company; Transmission Line Right of Way; Providence, RI* (Plan Nos. D-12148 through D-12155) (the "Plans.") The Plans identify parcels owned by the City of Providence and the State of Rhode Island over which Narragansett requires an easement. Narragansett will agree to release the easements for the overhead line after the construction of the Underground Alignment and the removal of the overhead line.

Wherefore, Narragansett respectfully requests that the City Council grant to Narragansett permanent easements as shown on the Plans for the construction of Phase I of the E-183 Line.

PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body

The Narragansett Electric Company ("Narragansett" or the "Company") respectfully petitions the City Council to grant to Narragansett permanent easements for an overhead transmission line in Fox Point and India Point as explained in detail below.

In April 2003, Narragansett filed an application with the Energy Facility Siting Board (the "EFSB") for approval to relocate Narragansett's existing E-183 115kV transmission line (the "E-183 Line") in order to accommodate the Rhode Island Department of Transportation's I-195 relocation project (the "I-195 Project.") As part of its filing, Narragansett proposed an overhead relocation which included the reconstruction of the transmission line crossings of the Providence and Seekonk Rivers.

The Cities of Providence and East Providence and the Rhode Island Attorney General objected to Narragansett's proposal and the parties have settled the case by Agreement dated May 25, 2004 (the "Settlement Agreement") which was approved by the EFSB on October 29, 2004. In re: The Narragansett Electric Company – E-183 155 kV Transmission Line Relocation Project, Docket No. SB-2003-01, Report and Order (Order No. 54, October 29, 2004).

Pursuant to the Settlement Agreement, the parties agreed that Narragansett would reconstruct the E-183 Line in two phases. Phase I is the portion of the E-183 Line between the east bank of the Providence River and the vicinity of its proposed pole number 7, located southeast of the Radisson Hotel near India Street. Phase I is to be relocated overhead to allow RIDOT to proceed with the I-195 Project, according to its schedule.

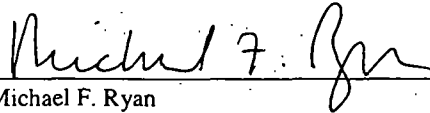
The parties also agreed that Narragansett would develop a route and design for the underground relocation of the E-183 Line from Franklin Square on the west bank of the Providence River to the east side of the Seekonk River which includes Phase I (the "Underground Alignment"). If the parties are able to obtain funding, property rights and permits for the Underground Alignment, Narragansett will rebuild this portion of the E-183 Line underground, and remove the Phase I overhead line.

In order to construct Phase I of the E-183 Project, Narragansett needs easements across City streets and other property owned by the City of Providence between the Providence River and the Seekonk River. Attached are plans prepared by Bryant Associates, Inc. for Maguire Group, Inc. entitled *The Narragansett Electric Company; Transmission Line Right of Way; Providence, RI* (Plan Nos. D-12148 through D-12155) (the "Plans.") The Plans identify parcels owned by the City of Providence and the State of Rhode Island over which Narragansett requires an easement. Narragansett will agree to release the easements for the overhead line after the construction of the Underground Alignment and the removal of the overhead line.

Wherefore, Narragansett respectfully requests that the City Council grant to Narragansett permanent easements as shown on the Plans for the construction of Phase I of the E-183 Line.

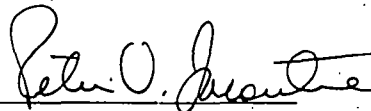
