RESOLUTION ENDORSING CONDEMNATION BY THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND OF LAND OWNED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND KNOWN AS CAMP CRONIN IN NARRAGANSETT, RHODE ISLAND

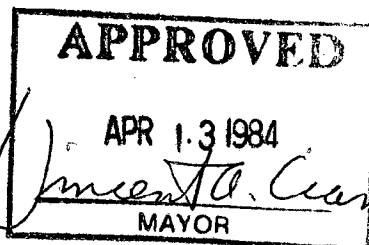
RESOLVED: (1) That the condemnation by the State of Rhode Island is hereby endorsed of that certain real estate owned by the City of Providence, designated as Lot No. 165 on Narragansett Assessor's Plat M, except that portion thereof consisting of approximately two and one-half (2½) acres, which is now or lately used for recreational or educational purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: (2) That pursuant to Section 1007(d) of the Providence City Charter, the Board of Contract and Supply is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with the State of Rhode Island (and, if necessary, the United States Government) with respect to the value of said property so taken, and shall have the authority to employ such experts as it shall deem necessary to assist it in connection with the condemnation thereof.
