

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 891

Approved December 14, 1975

WHEREAS, certain plans and preparations have been completed for the incising of names of all casualties of World War II, the Korean Conflict, and the Vietnam Conflict, on an appropriate memorial of late residents of the City of Providence, and

WHEREAS, the process of completing such a memorial have been stalemated in that the accuracy of said casualties, and of proper spelling of names, is questionable and from National official sources, there appears to be some question as to such accuracy,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor the Mayor is requested to cause the incising of names of all casualties of World War II, the Korean Conflict and of the Vietnam Conflict, who were residents of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, at the time of entry into the Armed Forces of the United States, on the proposed memorial, located at the Plaza of the Providence Civic Center, upon the satisfactory completion of the compilation of names as noted.
